

### **COMMUNITY AND SCHOOLS**

Clarkstown Central School District is located in a largely residential suburban community in Rockland County, 25 miles from New York City. There are two high schools (North and South) comprised of grades 9-12. Both high schools have been accredited by the New York State Department of Education and the Middle States Association. The district's reputation and commitment to academic excellence has been noted since its establishment in 1949.

## **FACULTY AND SERVICES**

South High School is staffed by a principal, three assistant principals, school counselors, psychologists, student assistance counselors, nurses, speech therapists, librarians and school resource officers. In addition to the regular classroom staff, the district provides a full range of special educational services from academic assistance and resource rooms to self-contained programs.

### **GRADING SYSTEM**

Clarkstown uses a numeric grading system, (0 -100%), in which 65.00 is the lowest passing grade.

GPA is based on all high school courses completed. Numeric course grades on the transcript do not reflect weighting but are the actual course grades earned. The GPA reflects appropriate weighting of these grades. Only Honors, IB & AP classes are weighted.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Clarkstown High School South (along with all New York State High Schools) shifted to online learning from March 17, 2020 through the end of the 2019-2020 school year.
