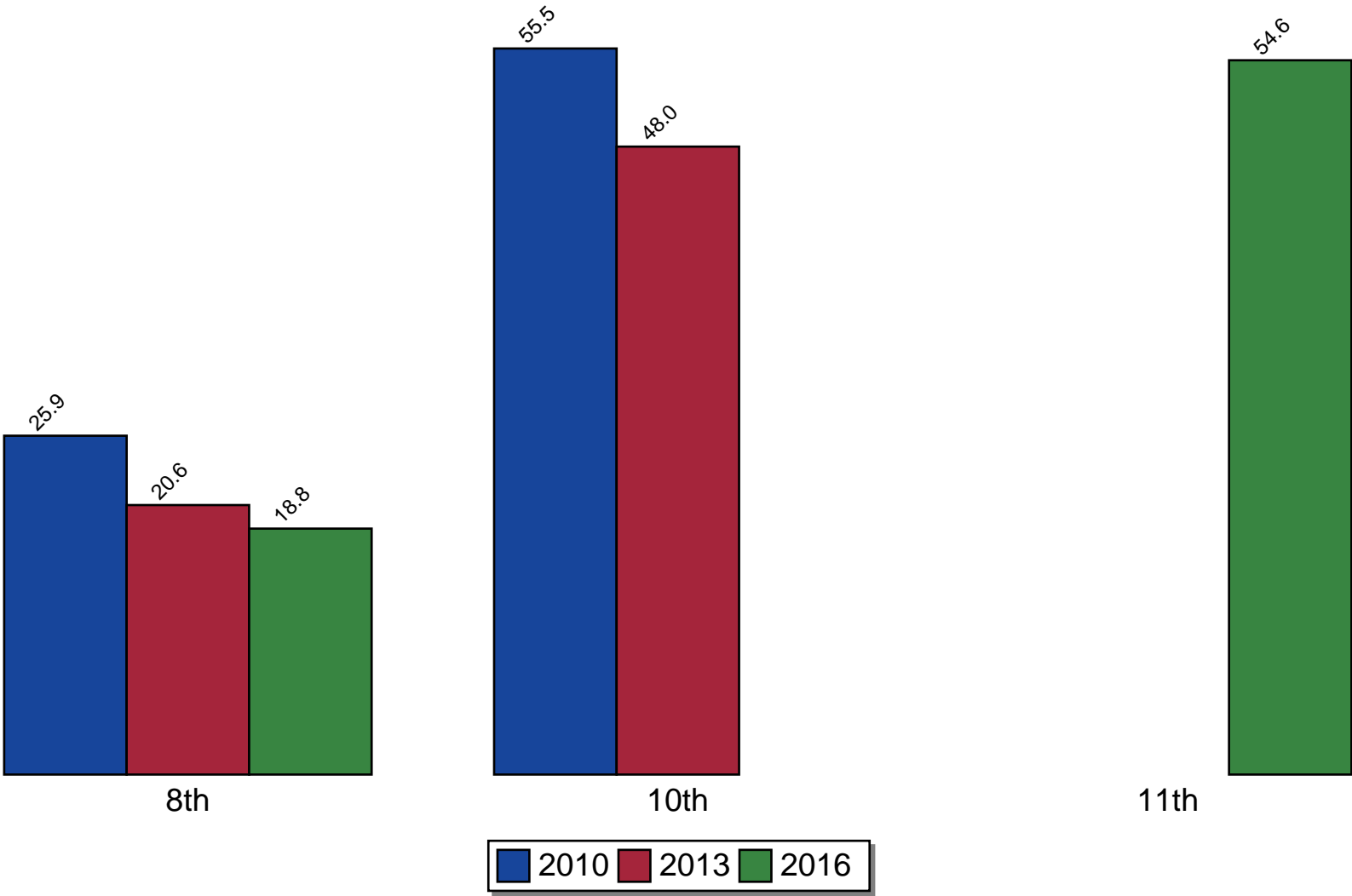

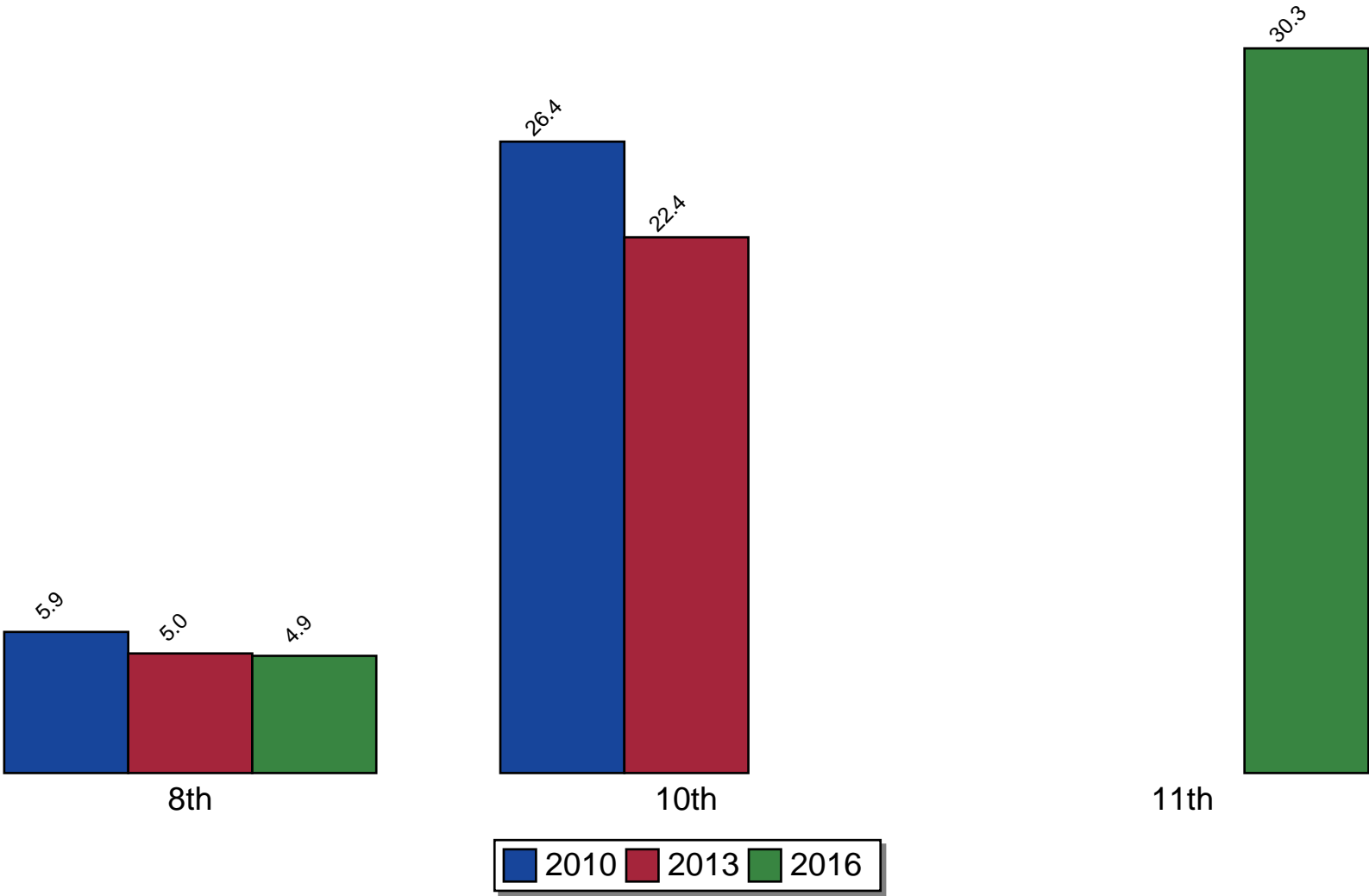

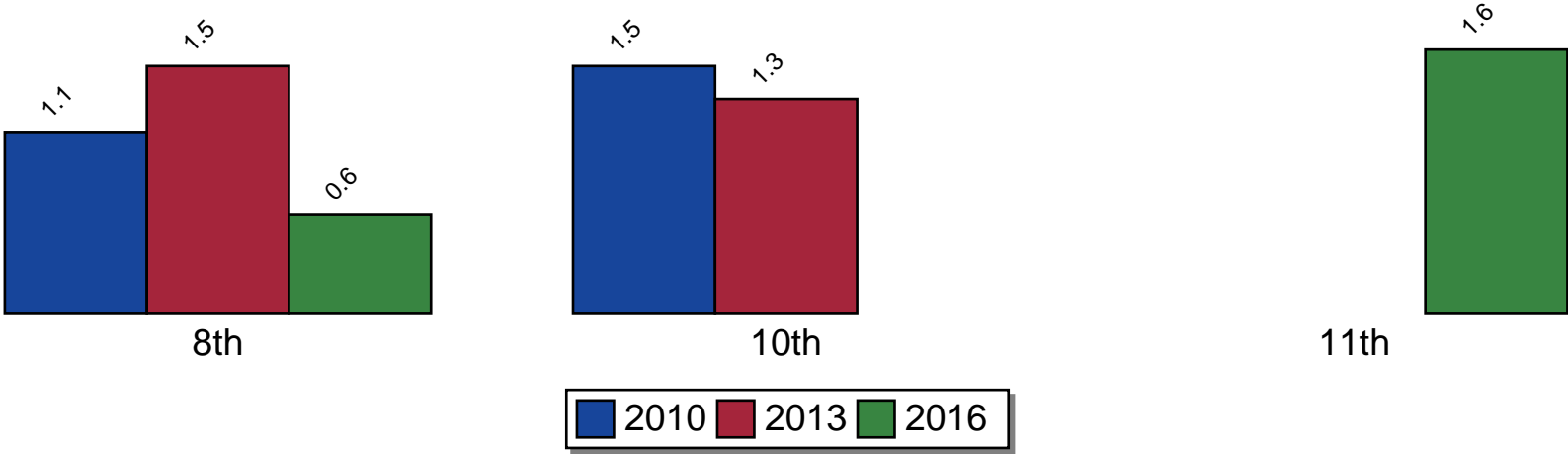

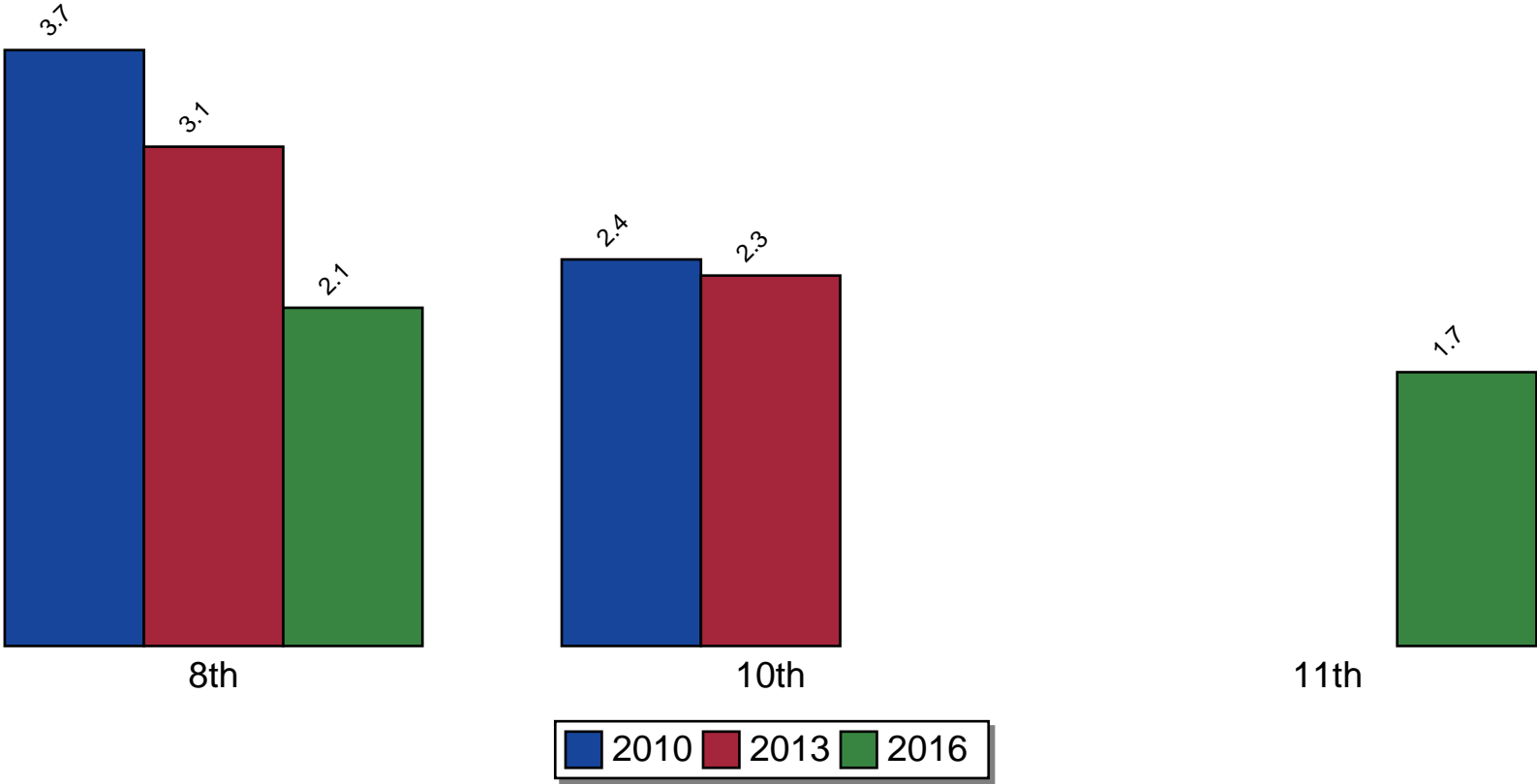

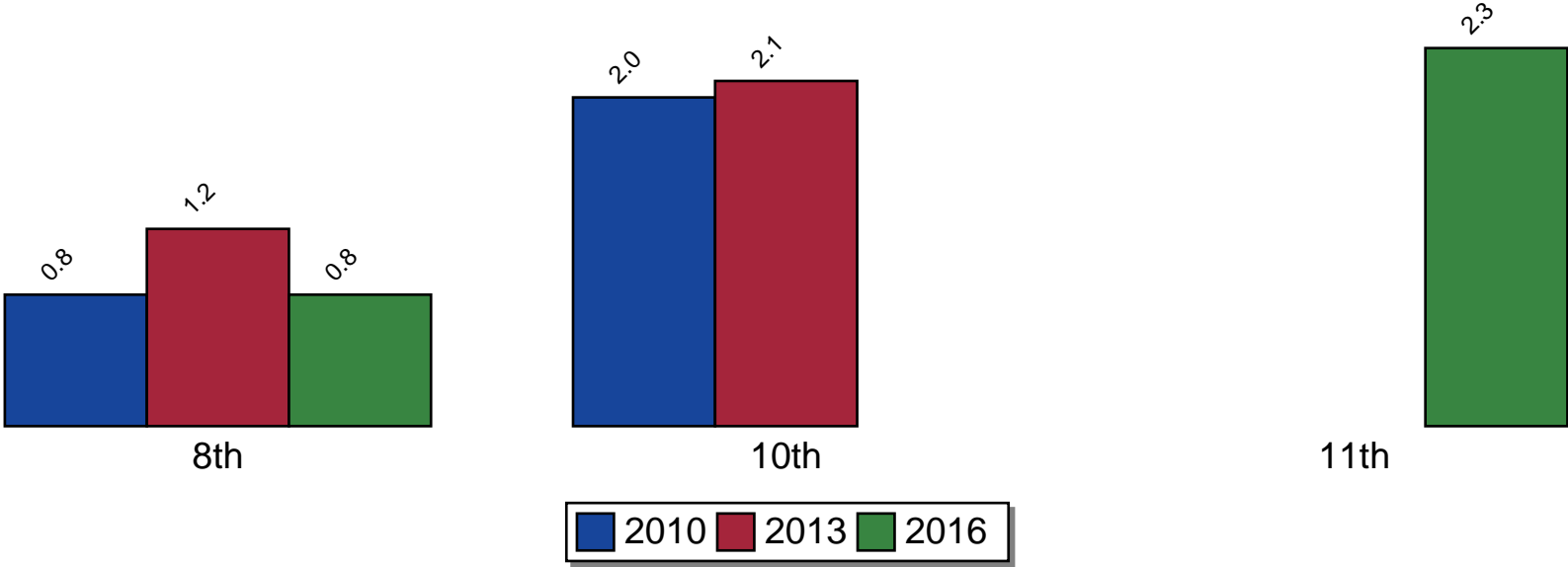

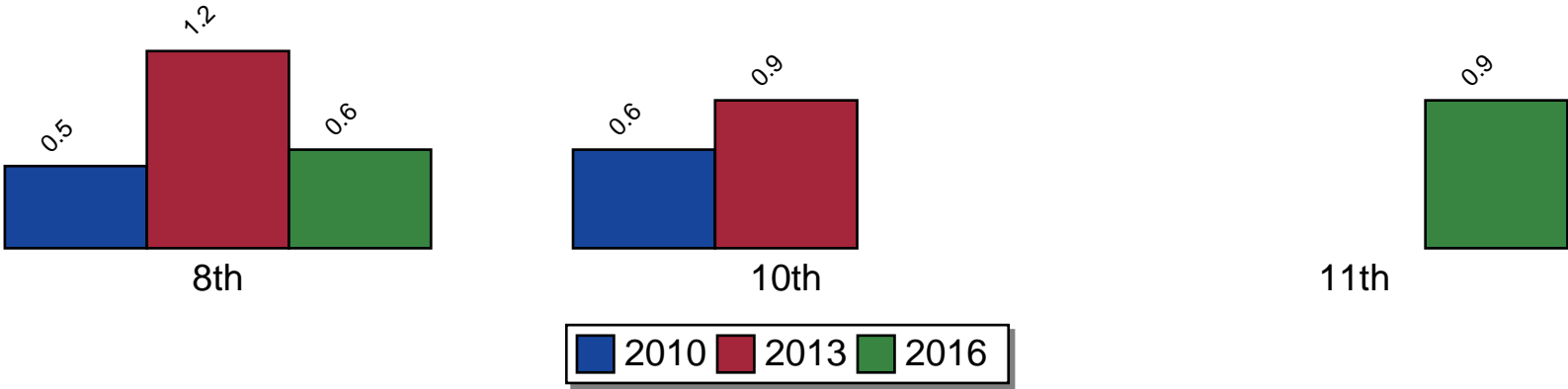

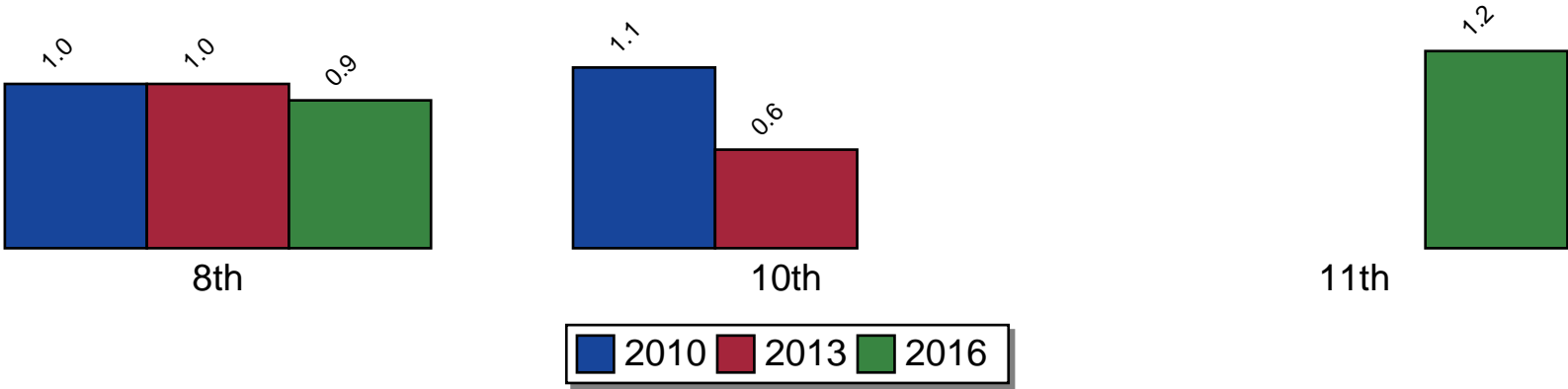

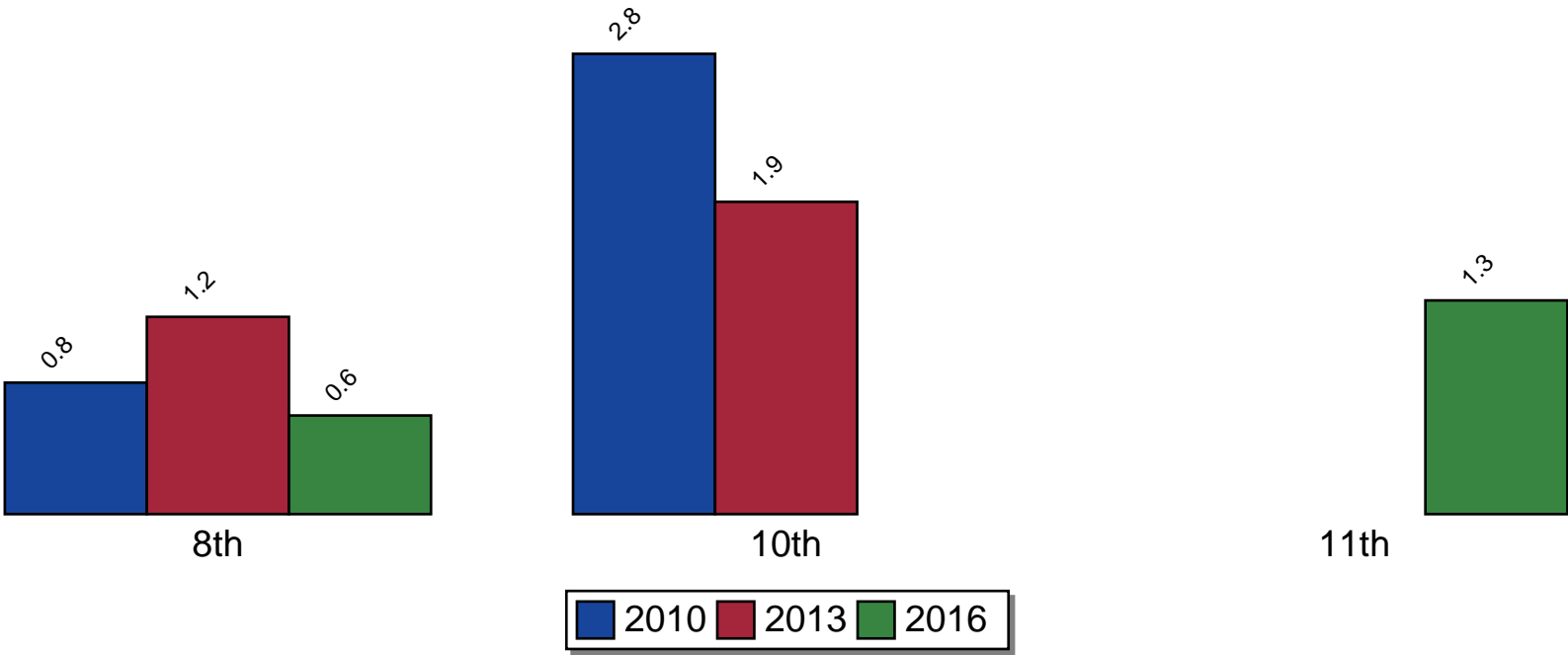

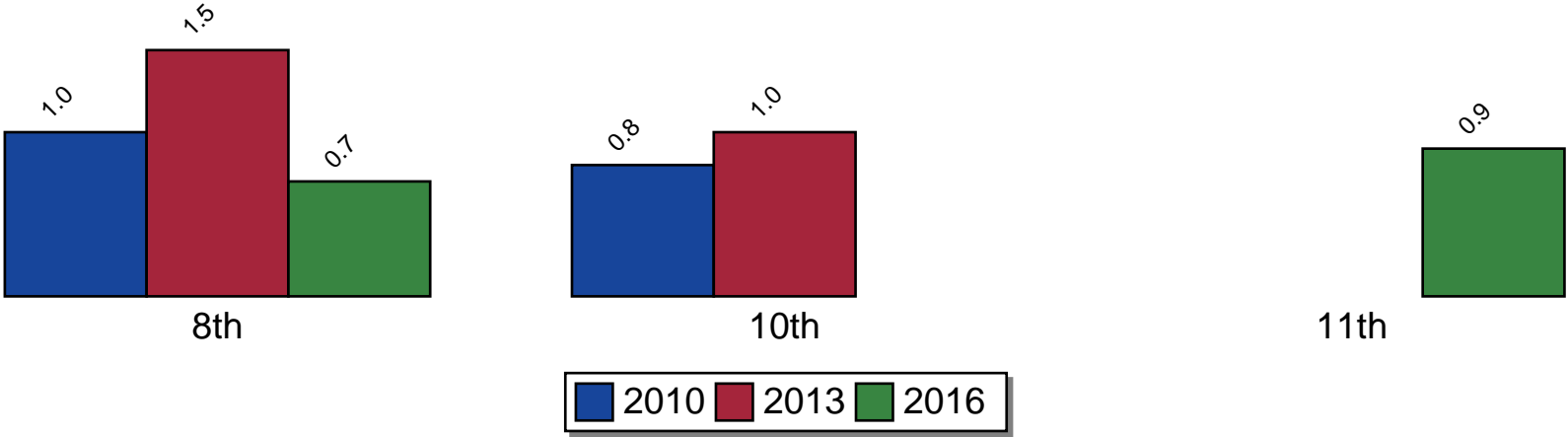

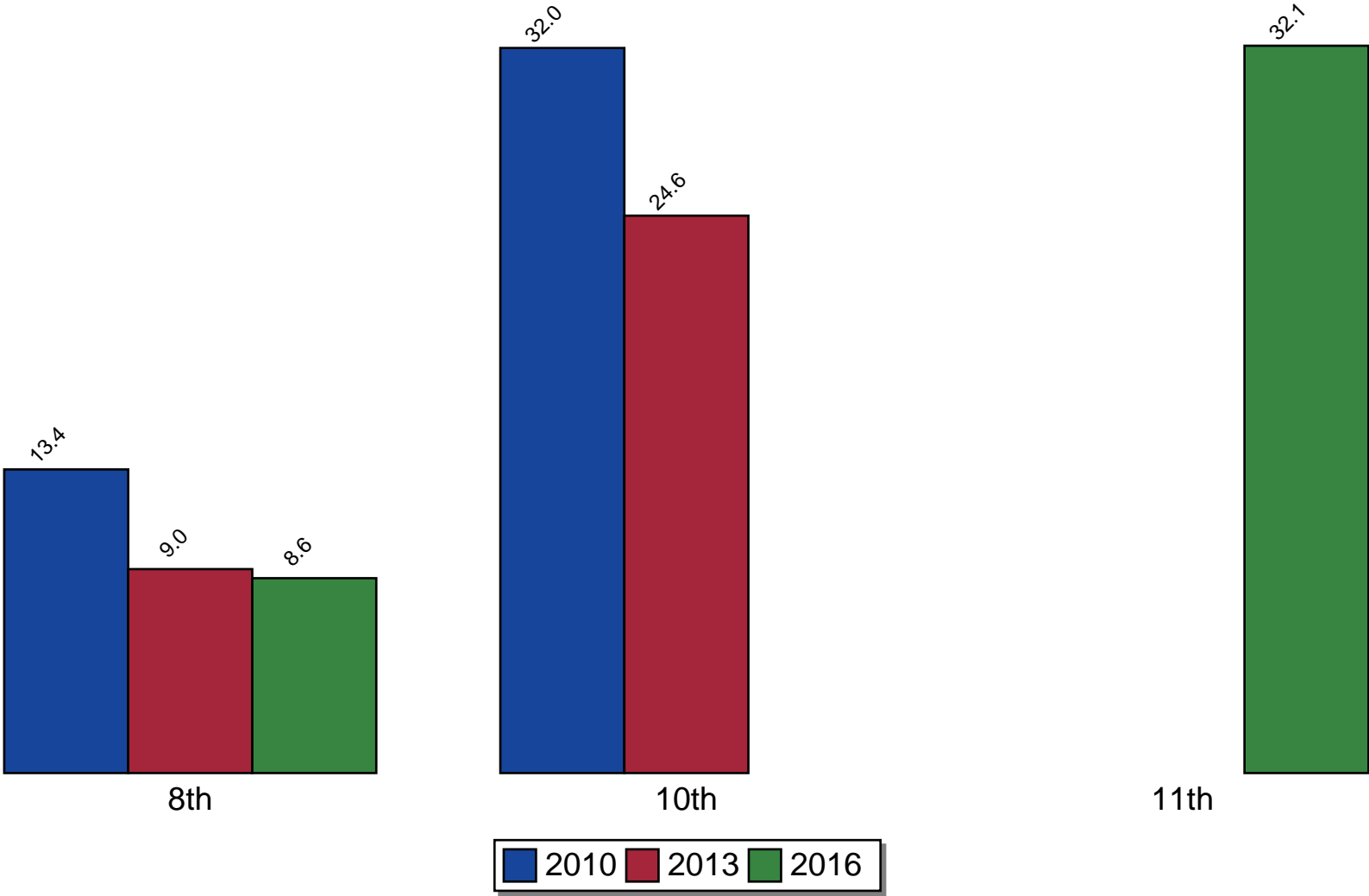

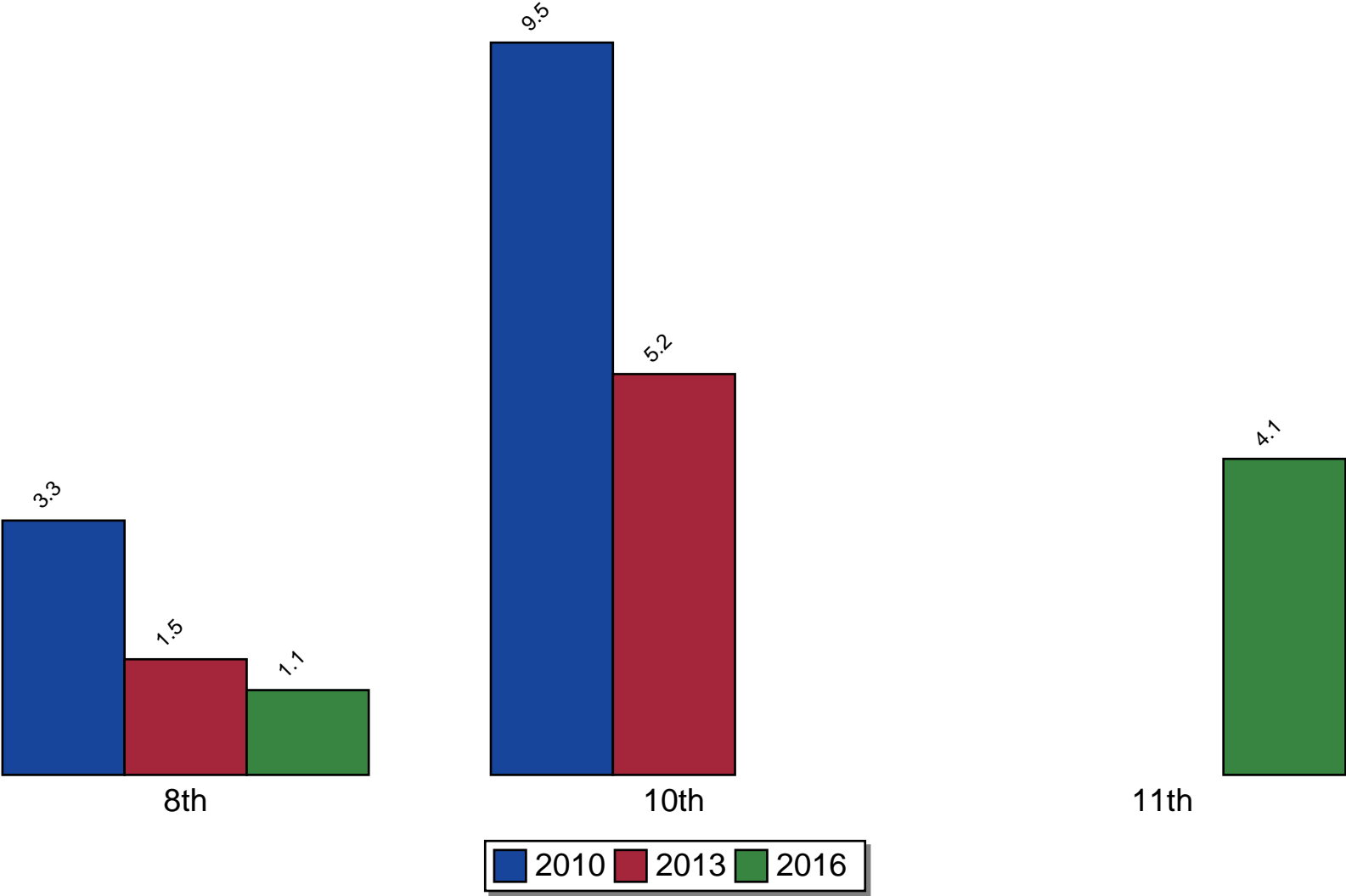

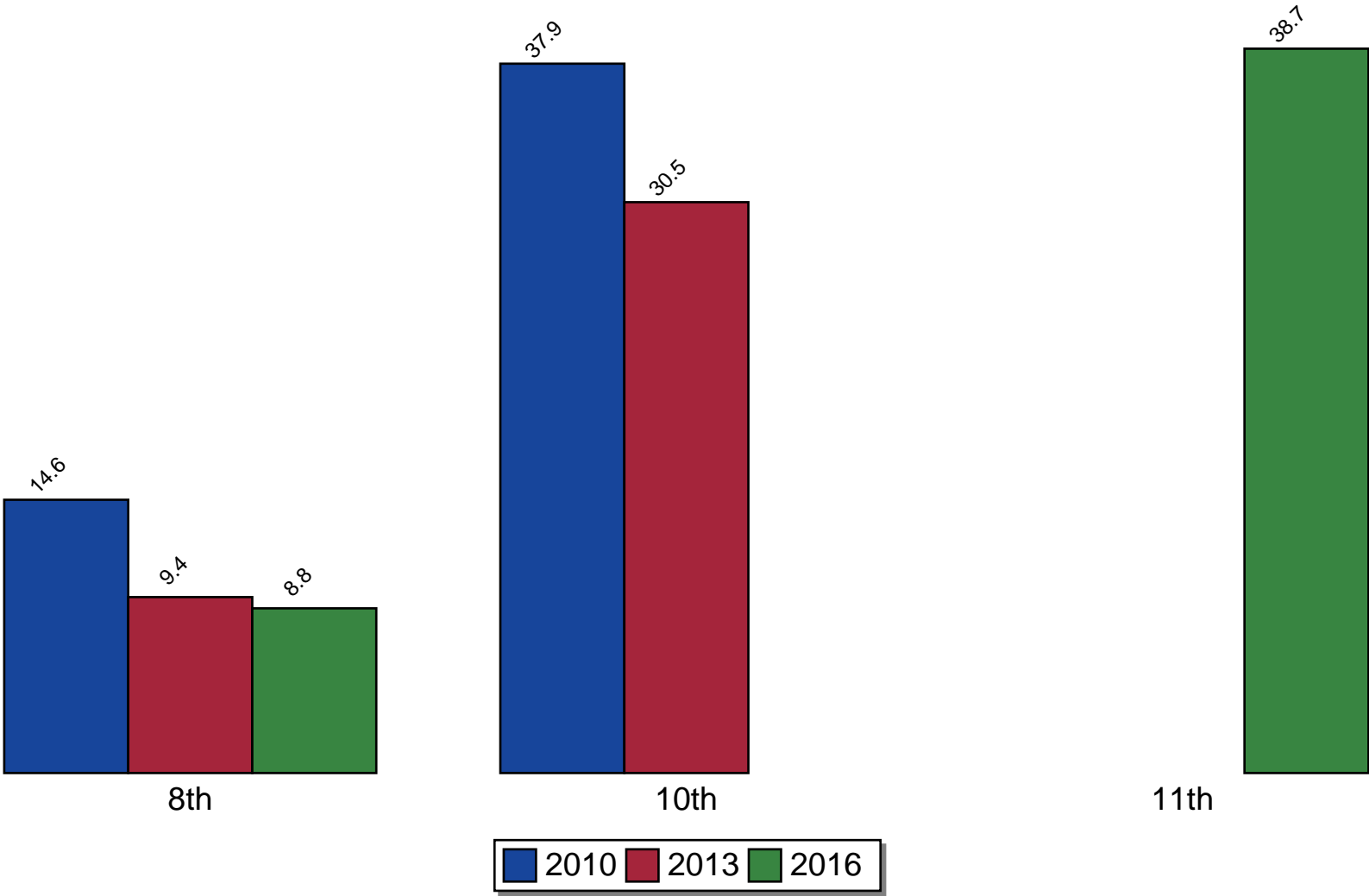

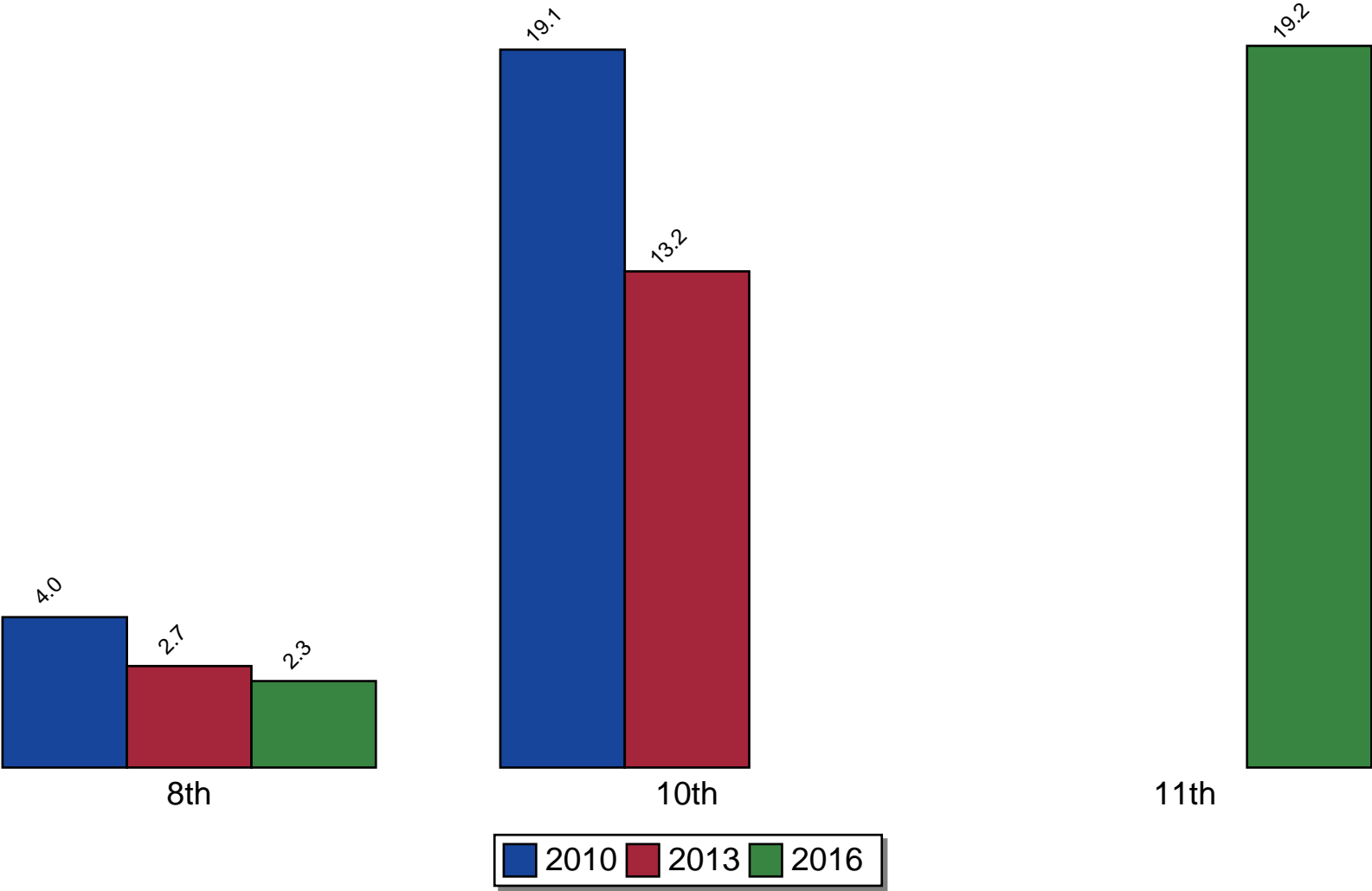

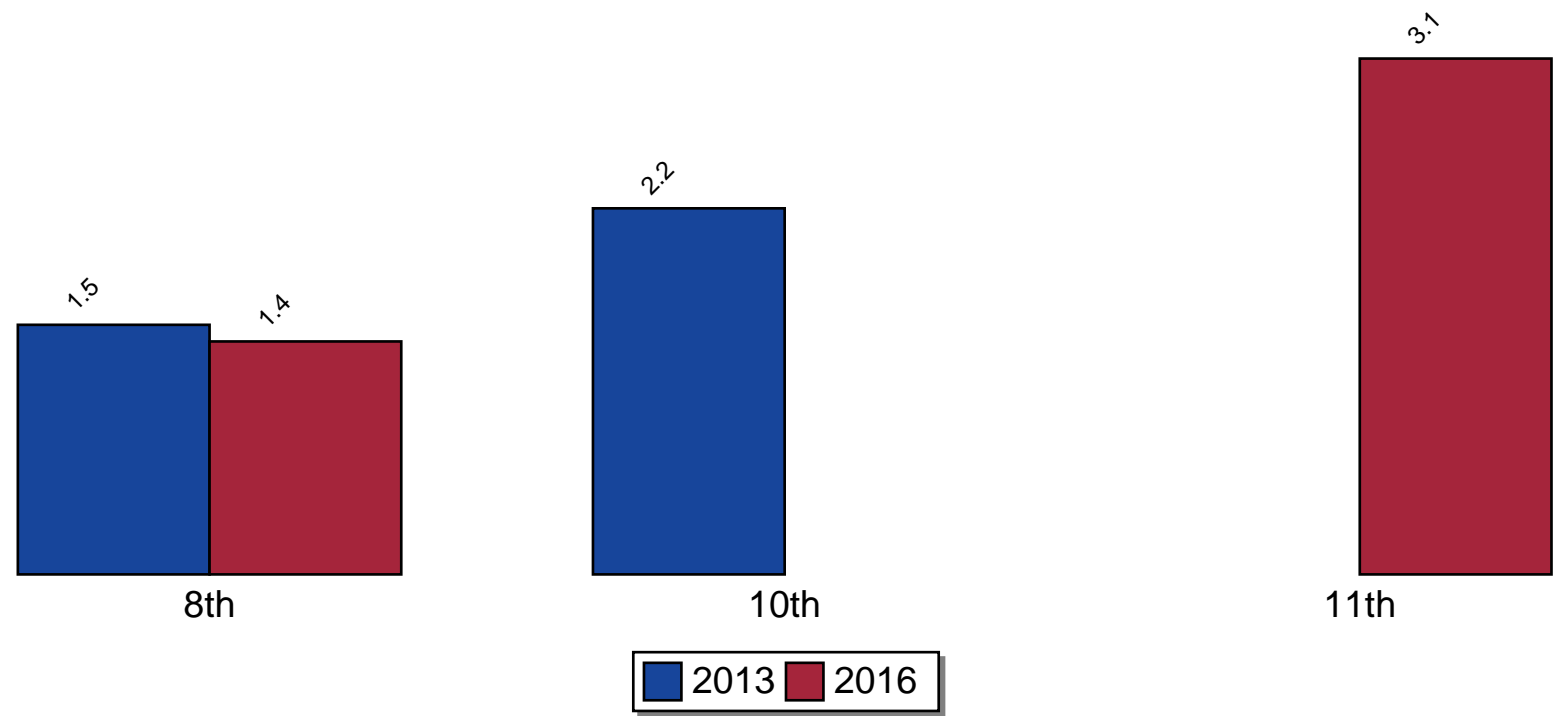

Past 30 Day Use of Prescription Drugs



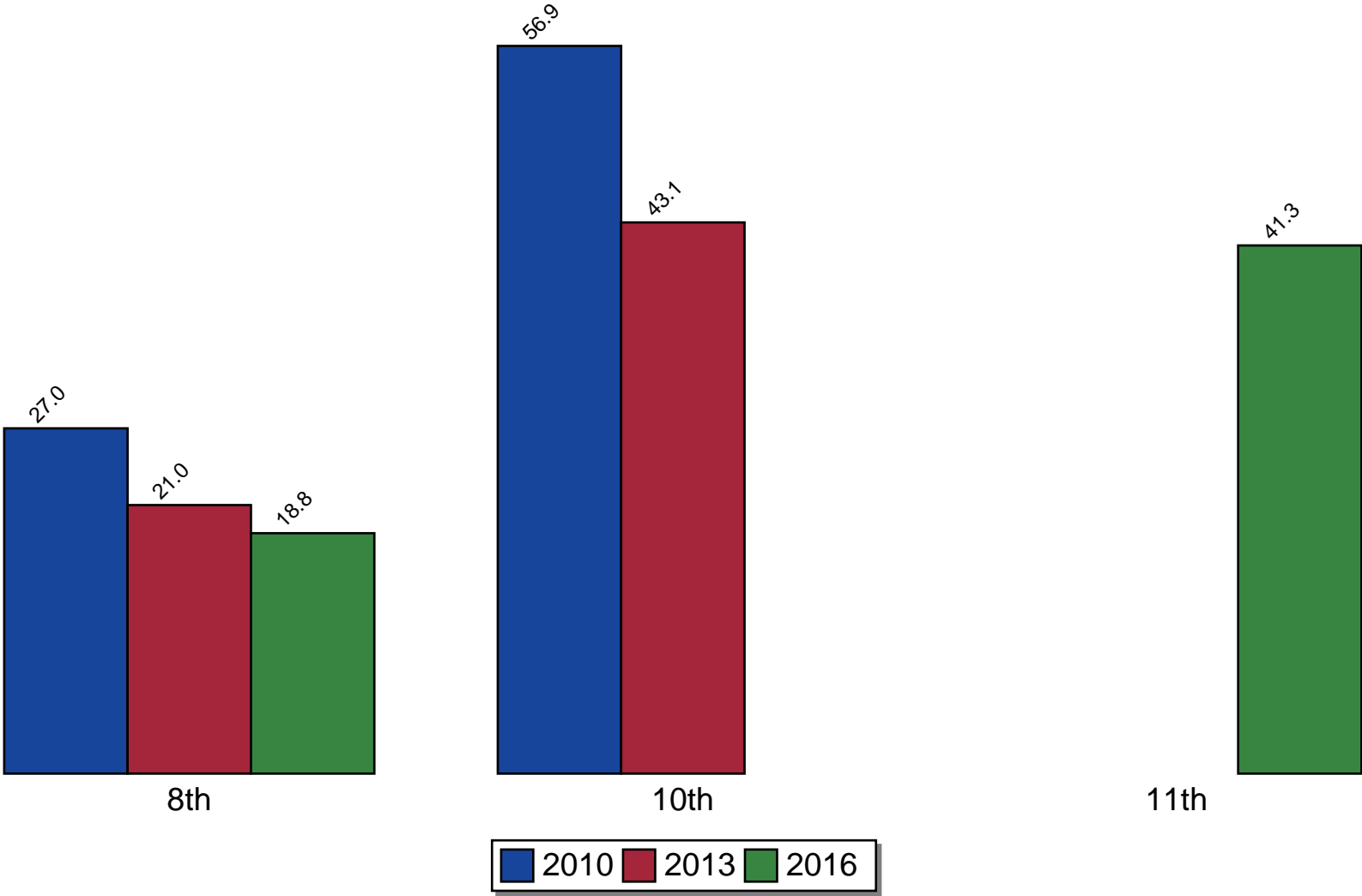

The third set of graphs present data on the availability of drugs. Each graph presents the percent of students who report a drug as being *Sort of Easy* or *Very Easy* to get.

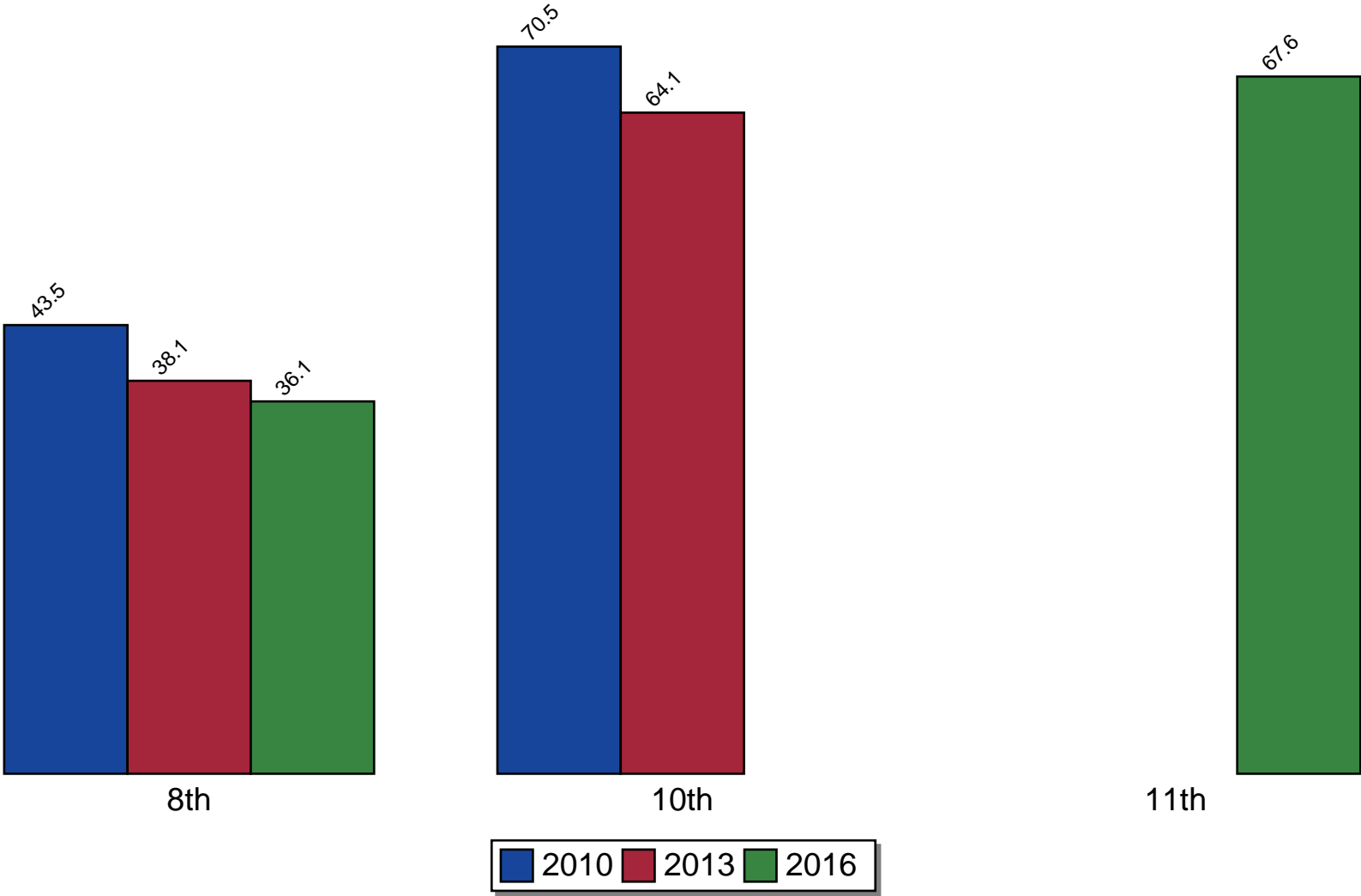

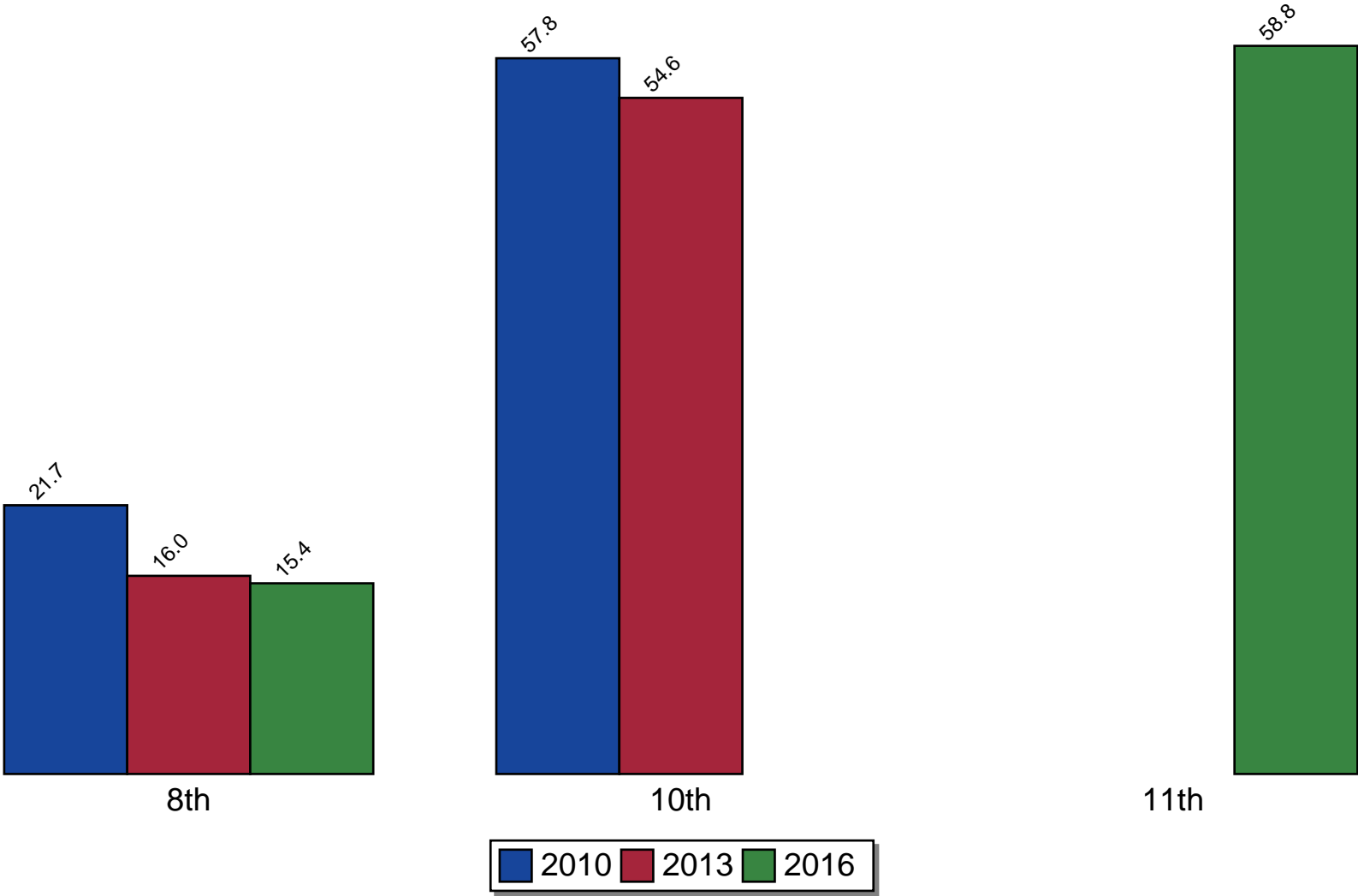

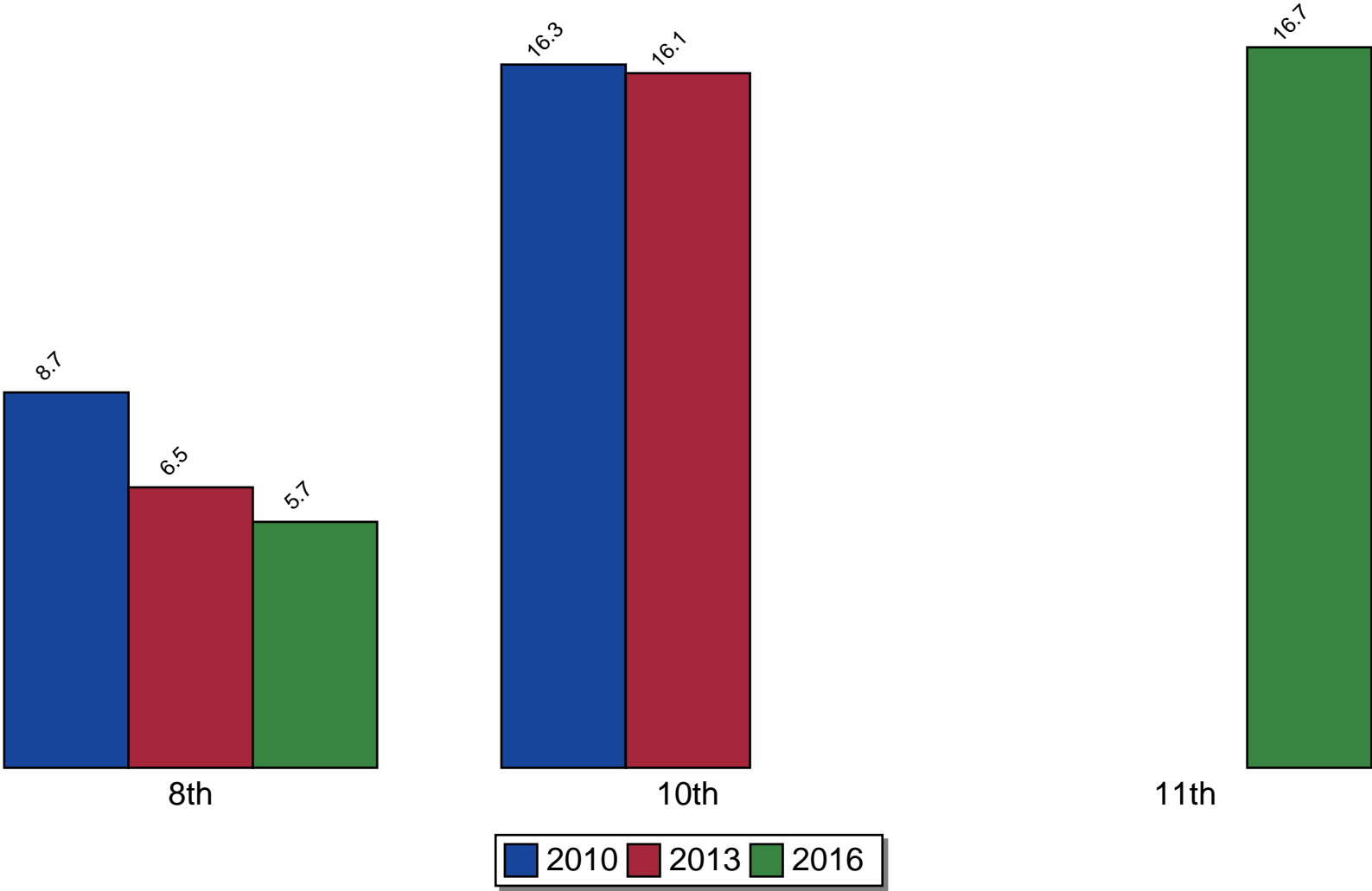

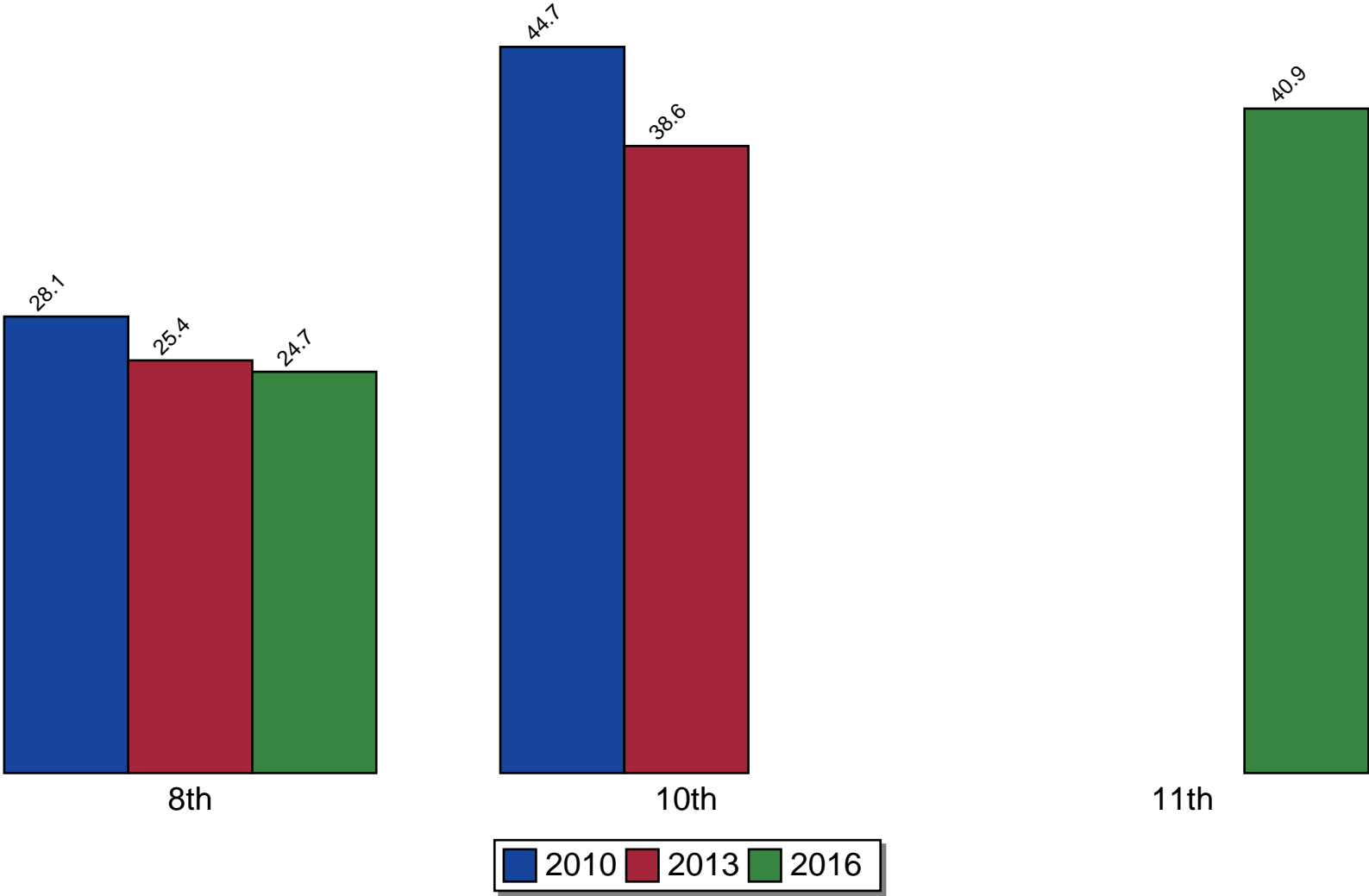

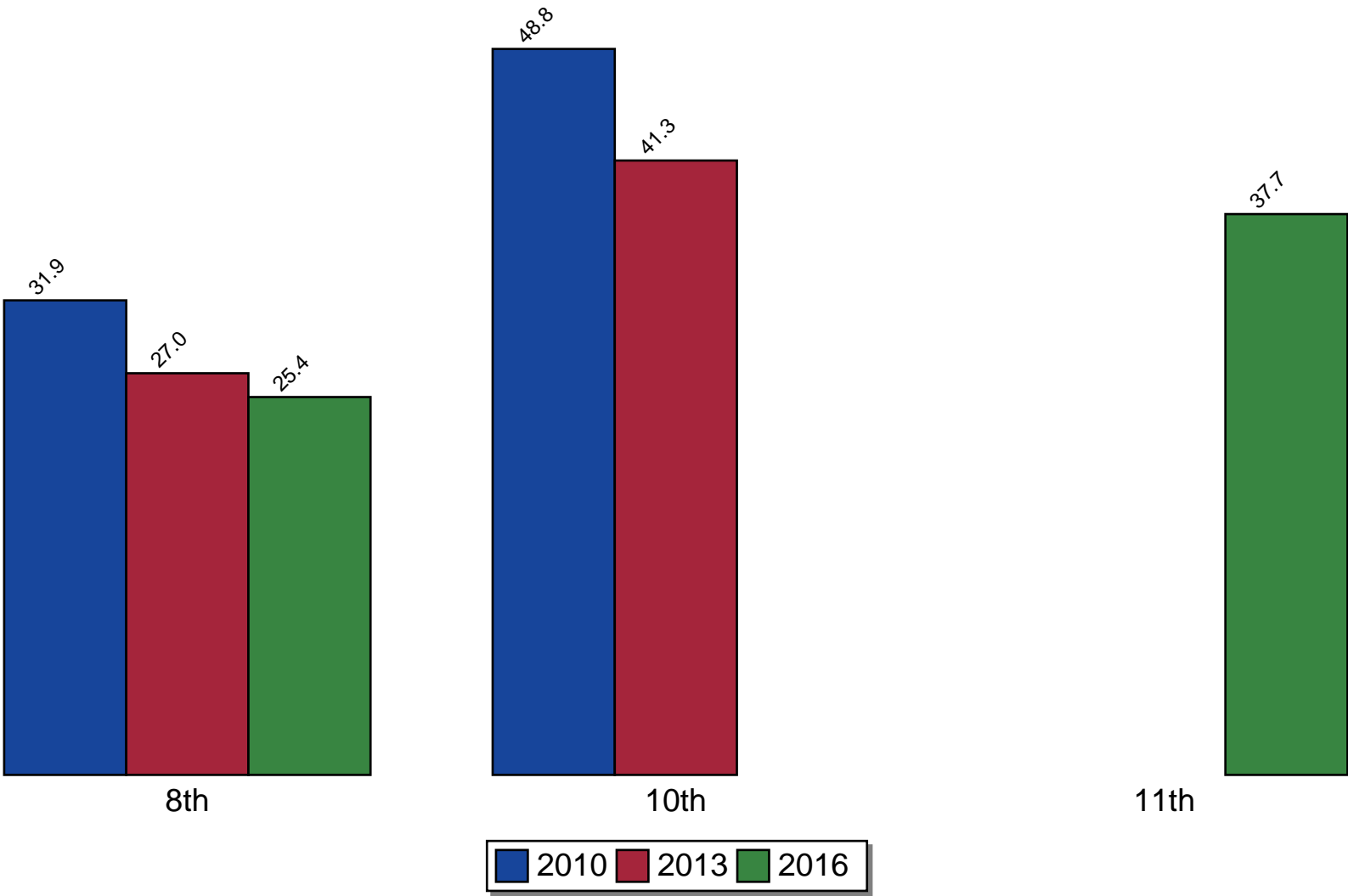

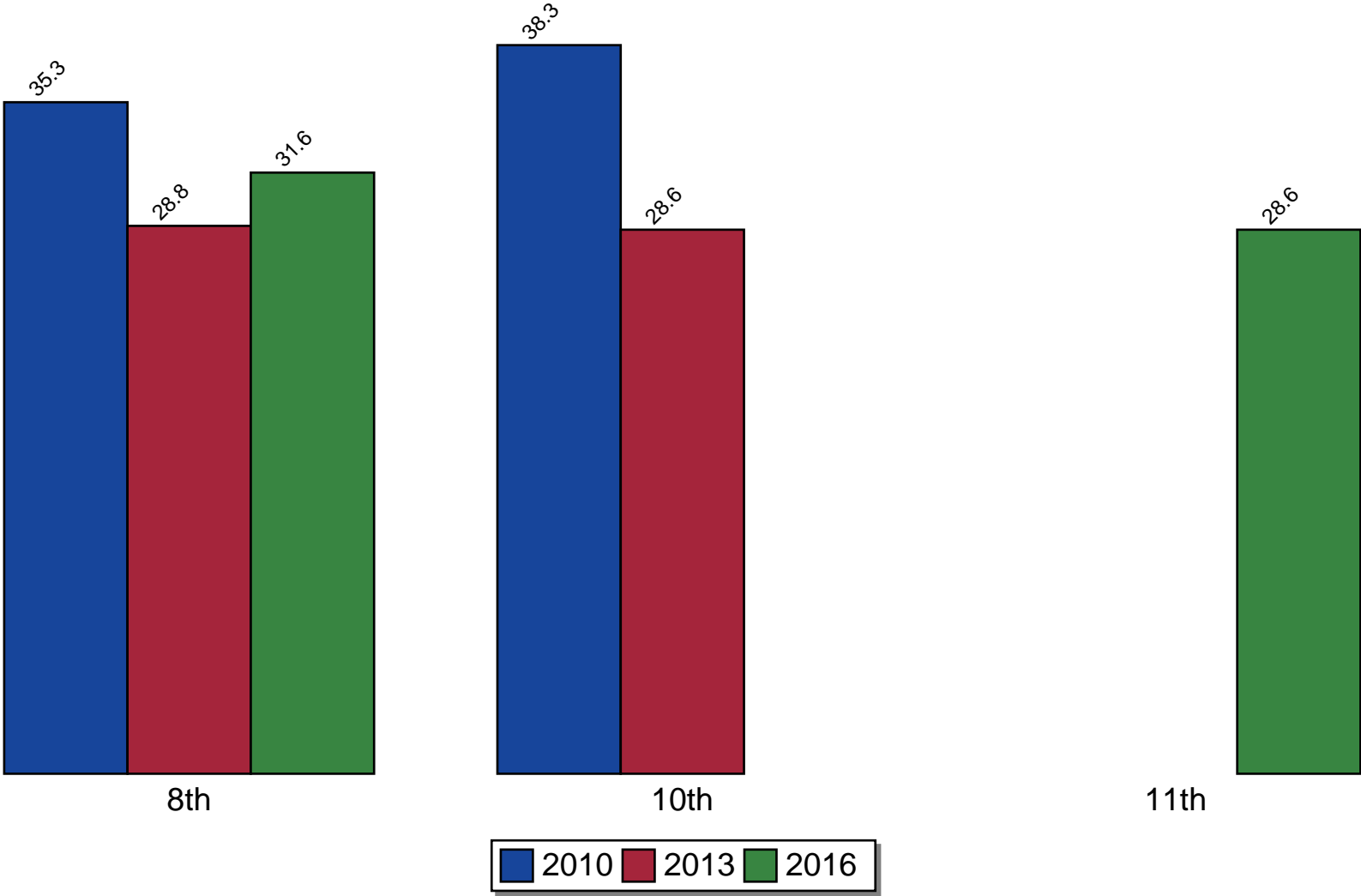

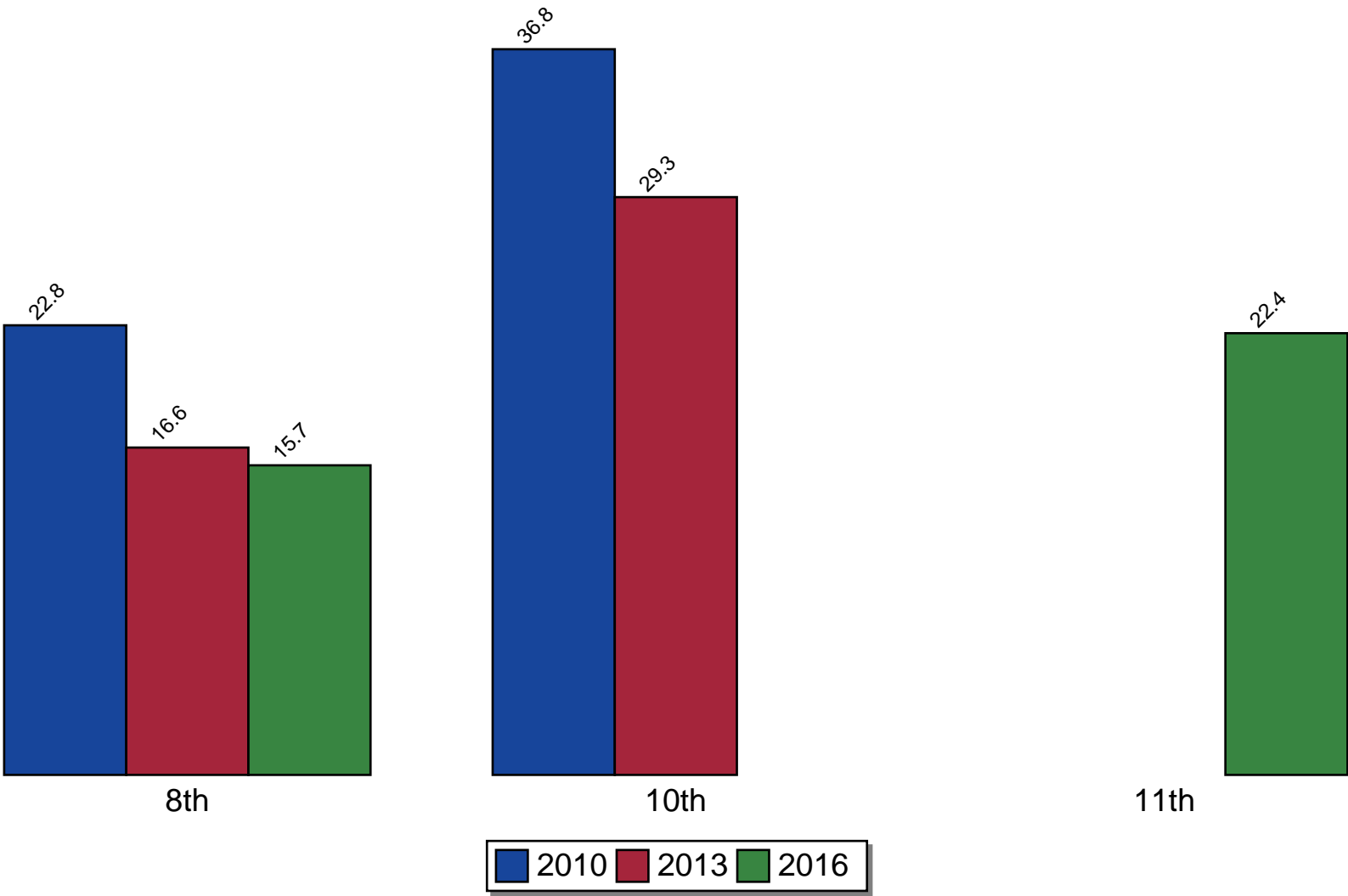

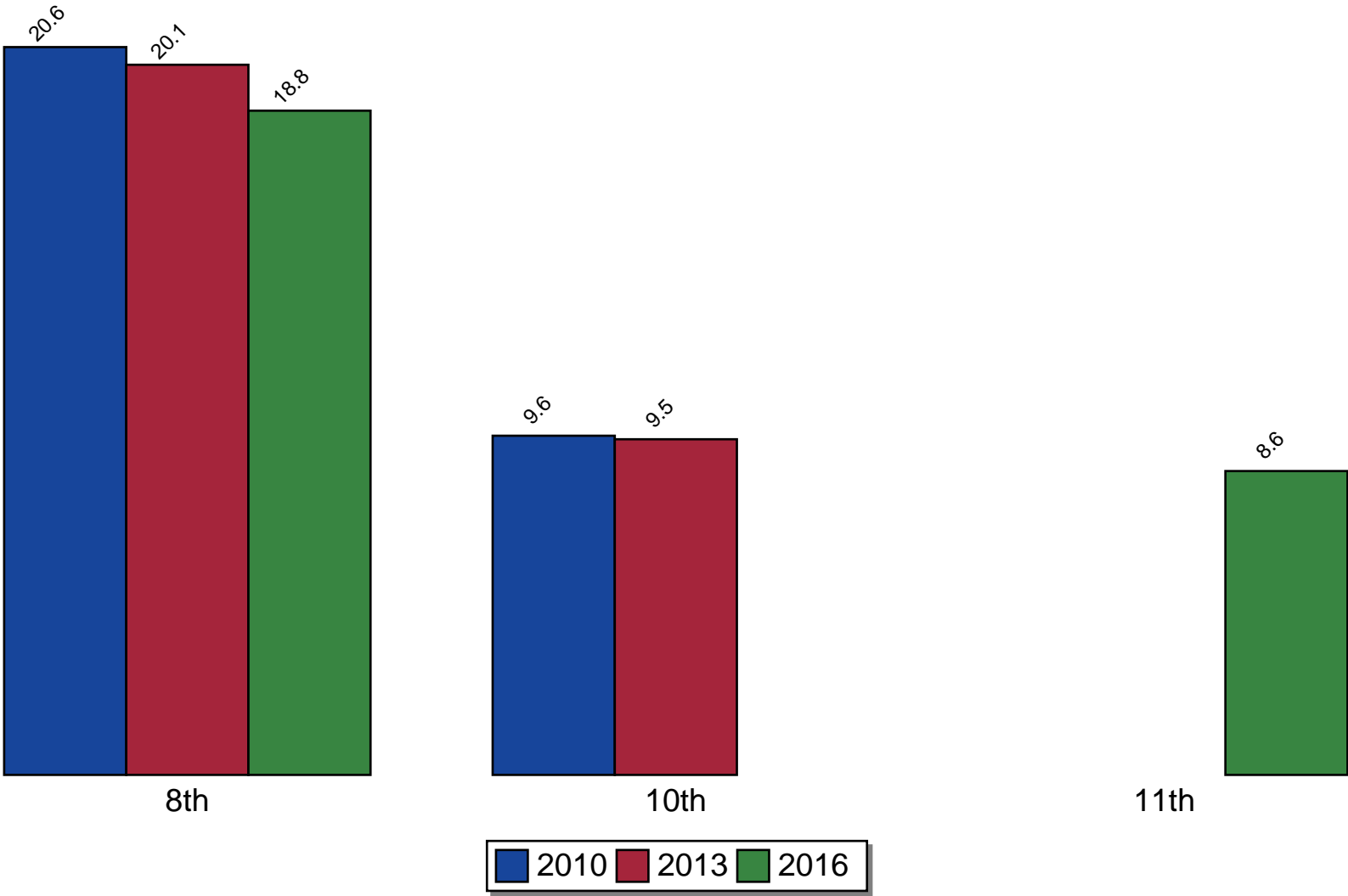

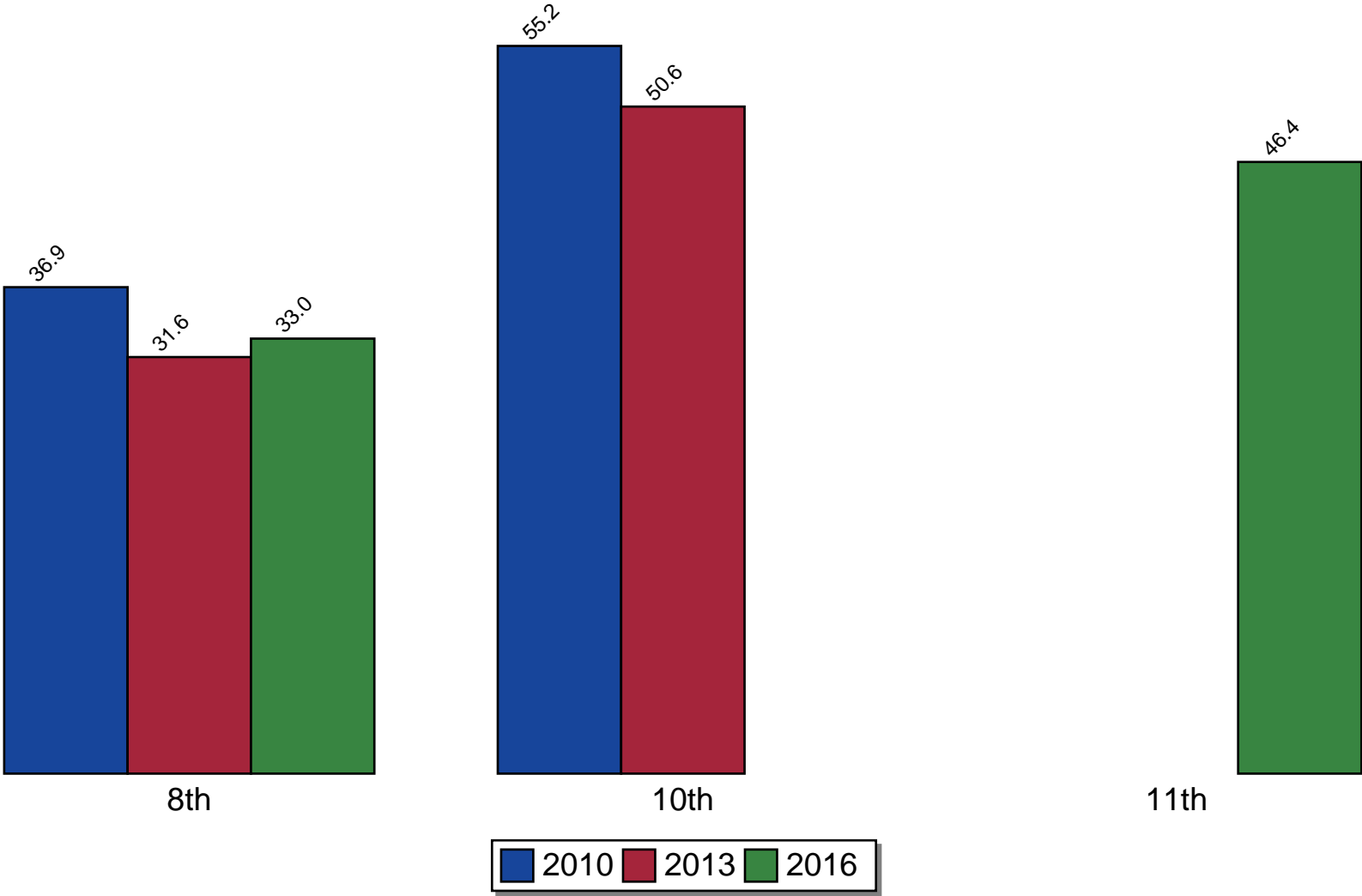

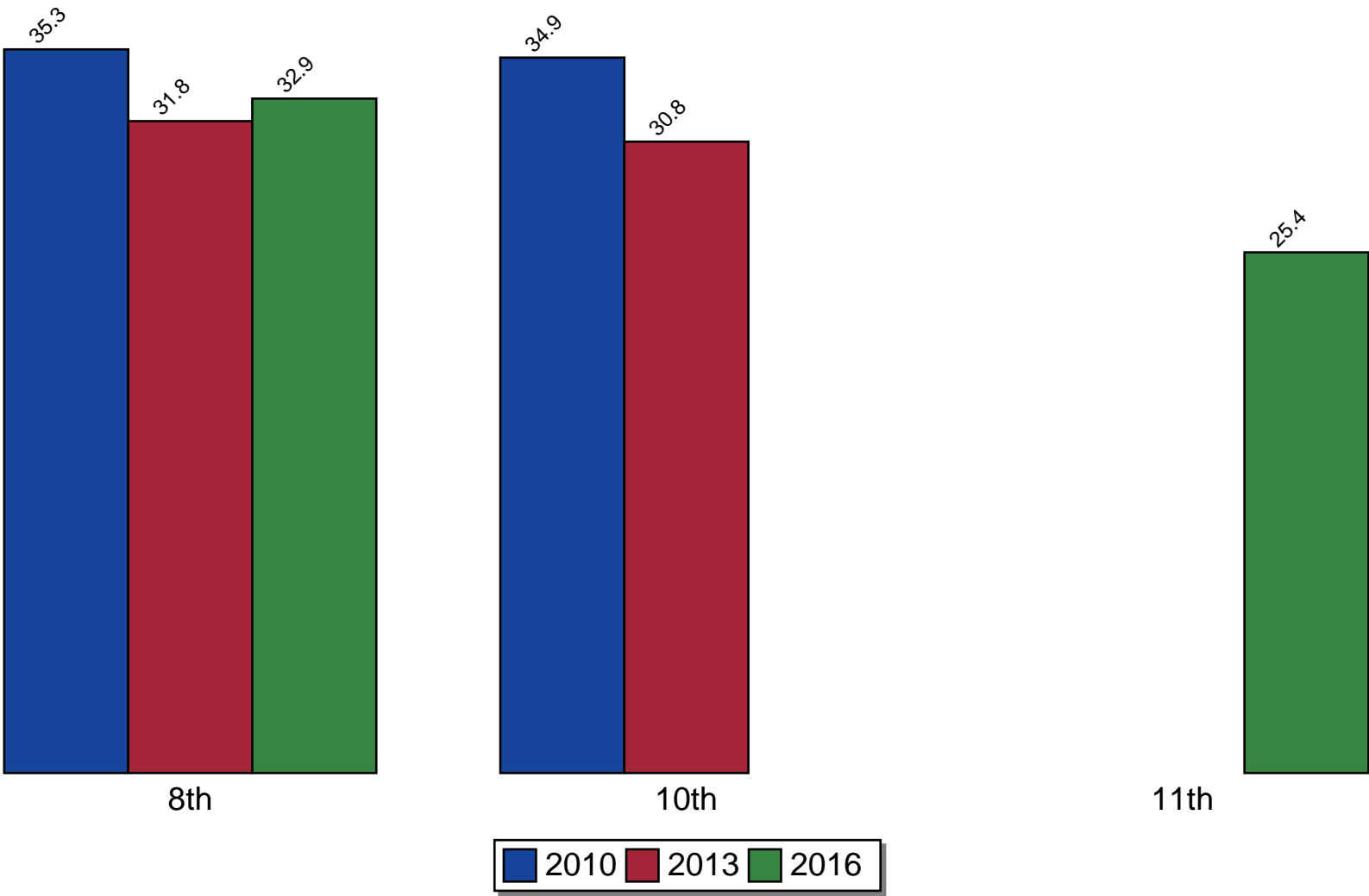

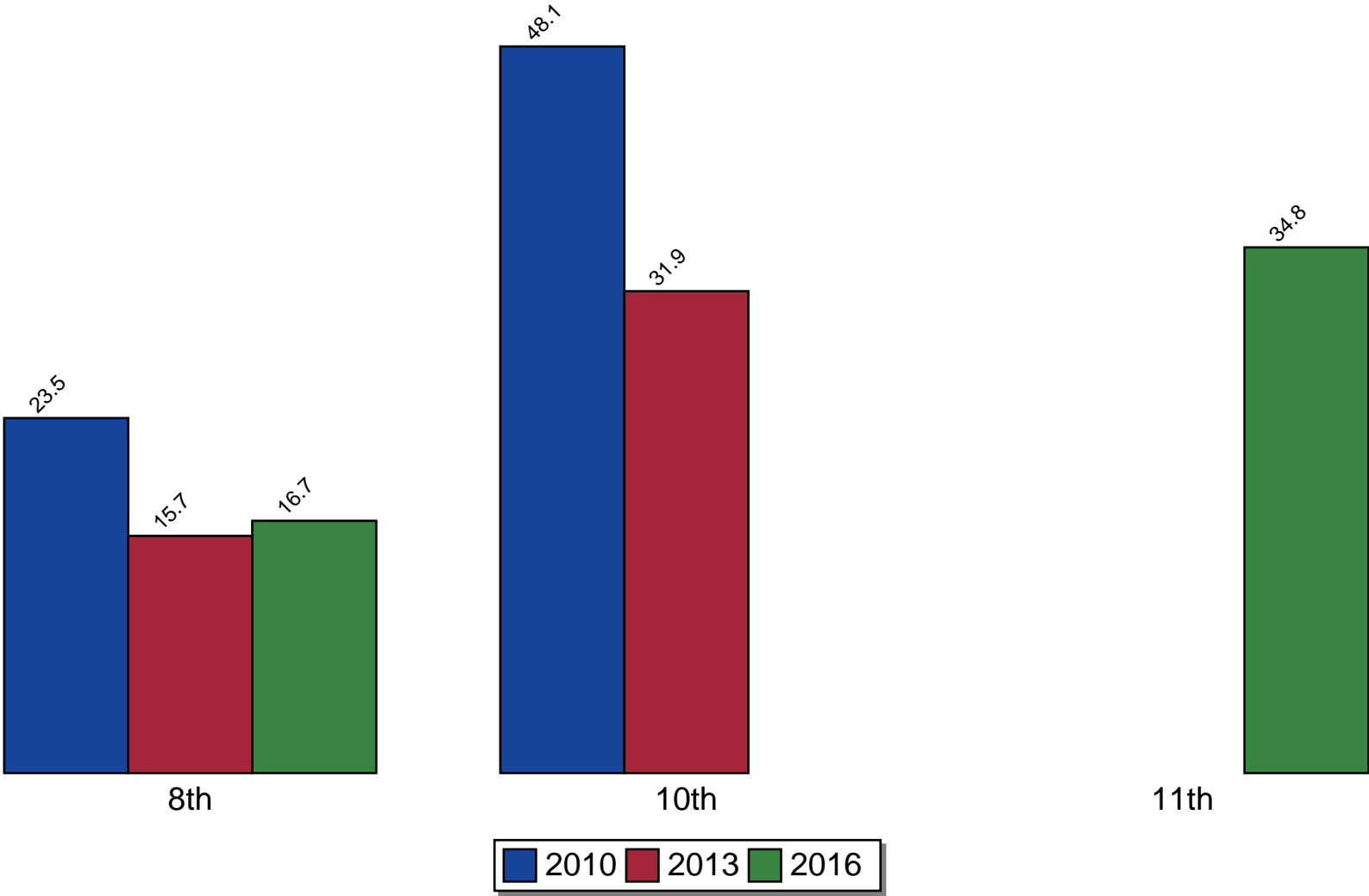

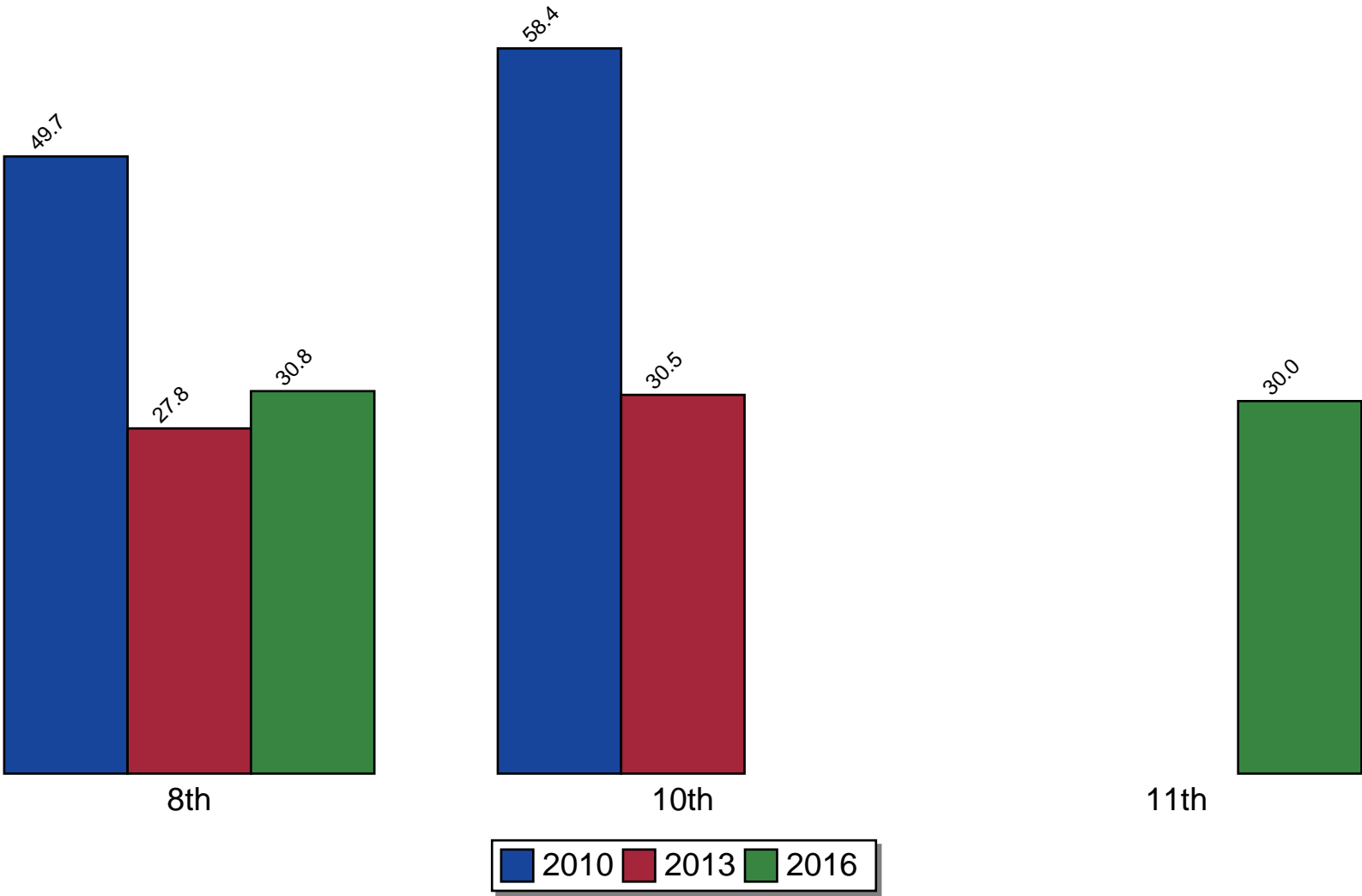

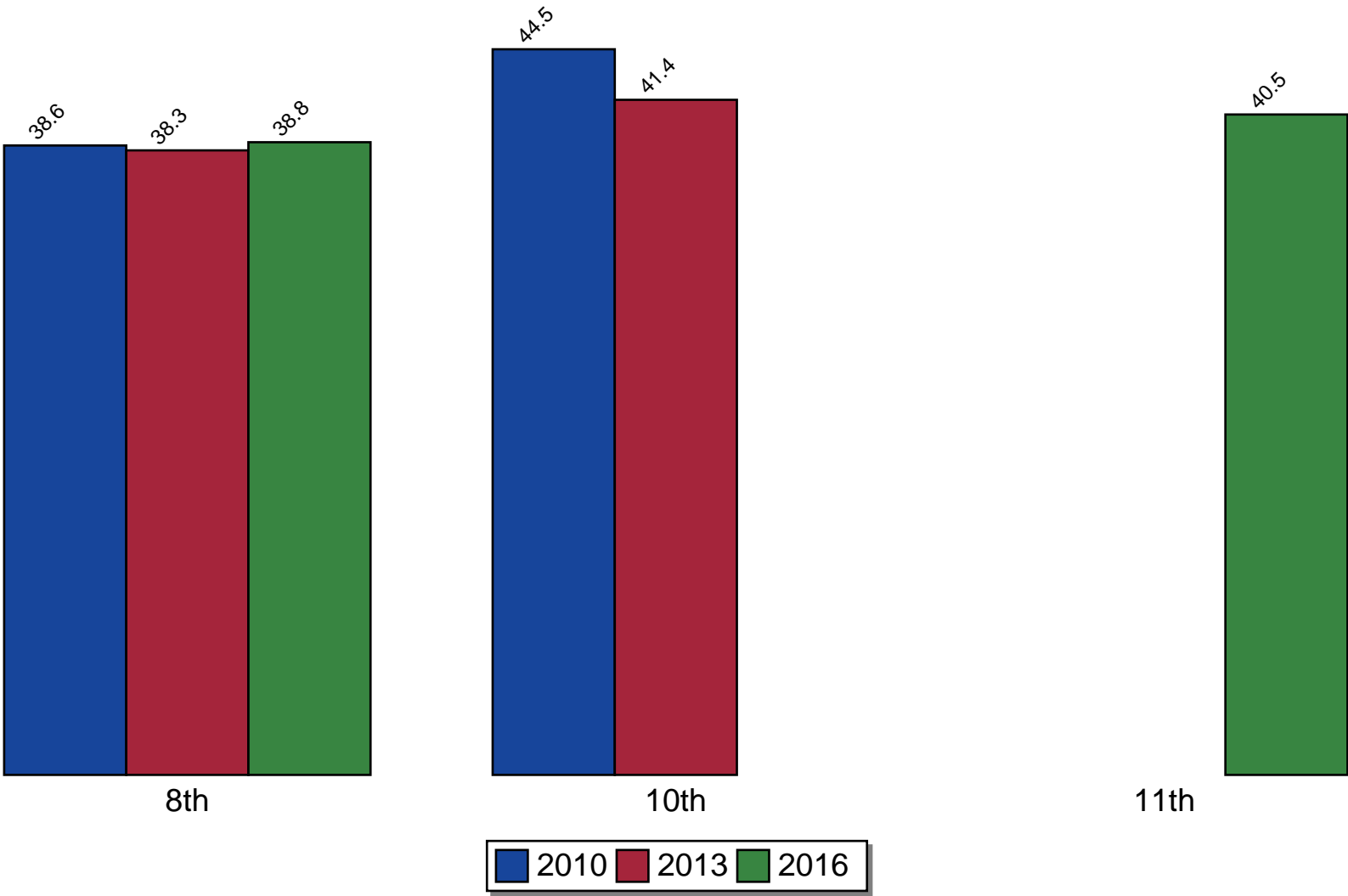

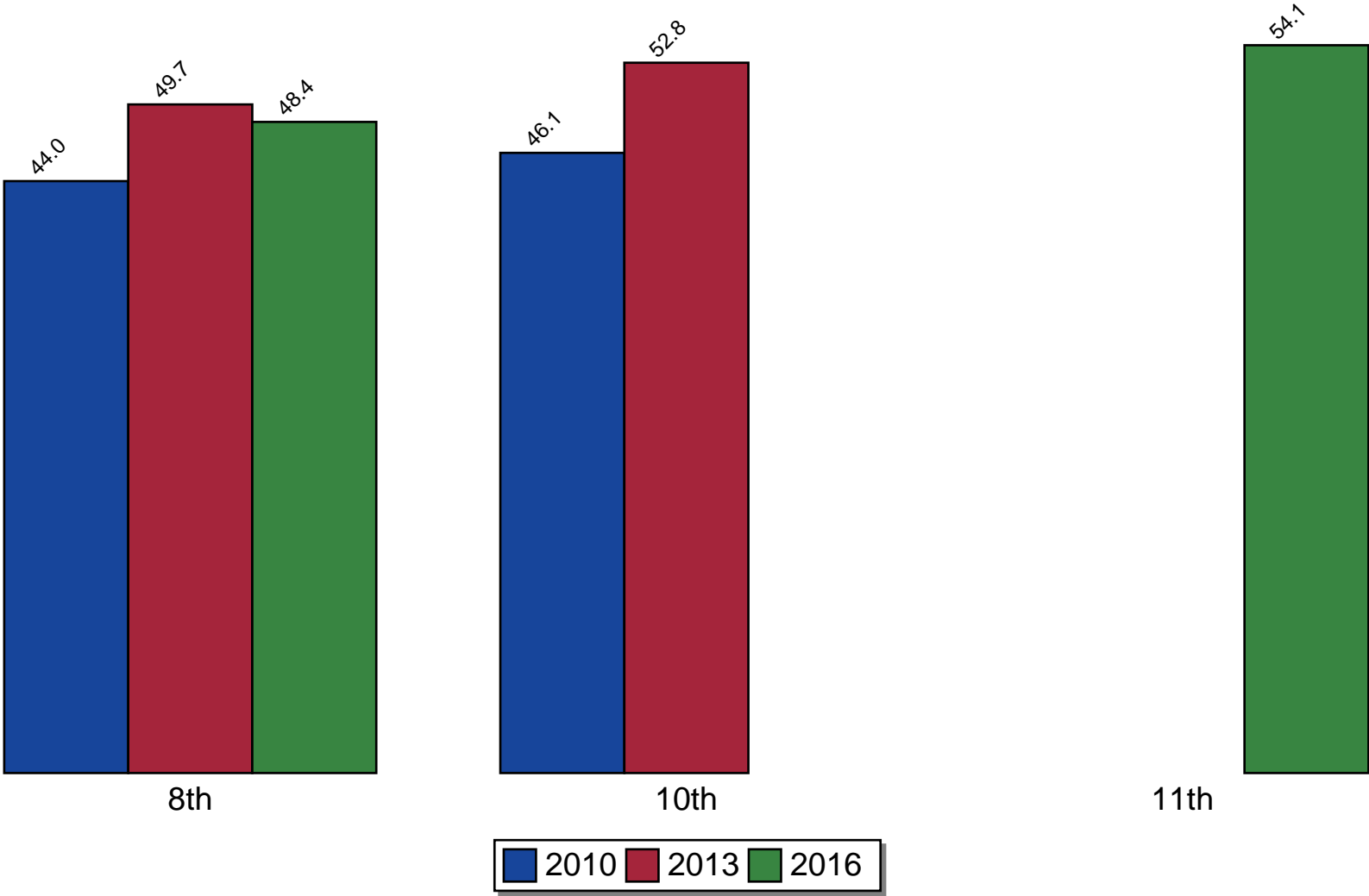

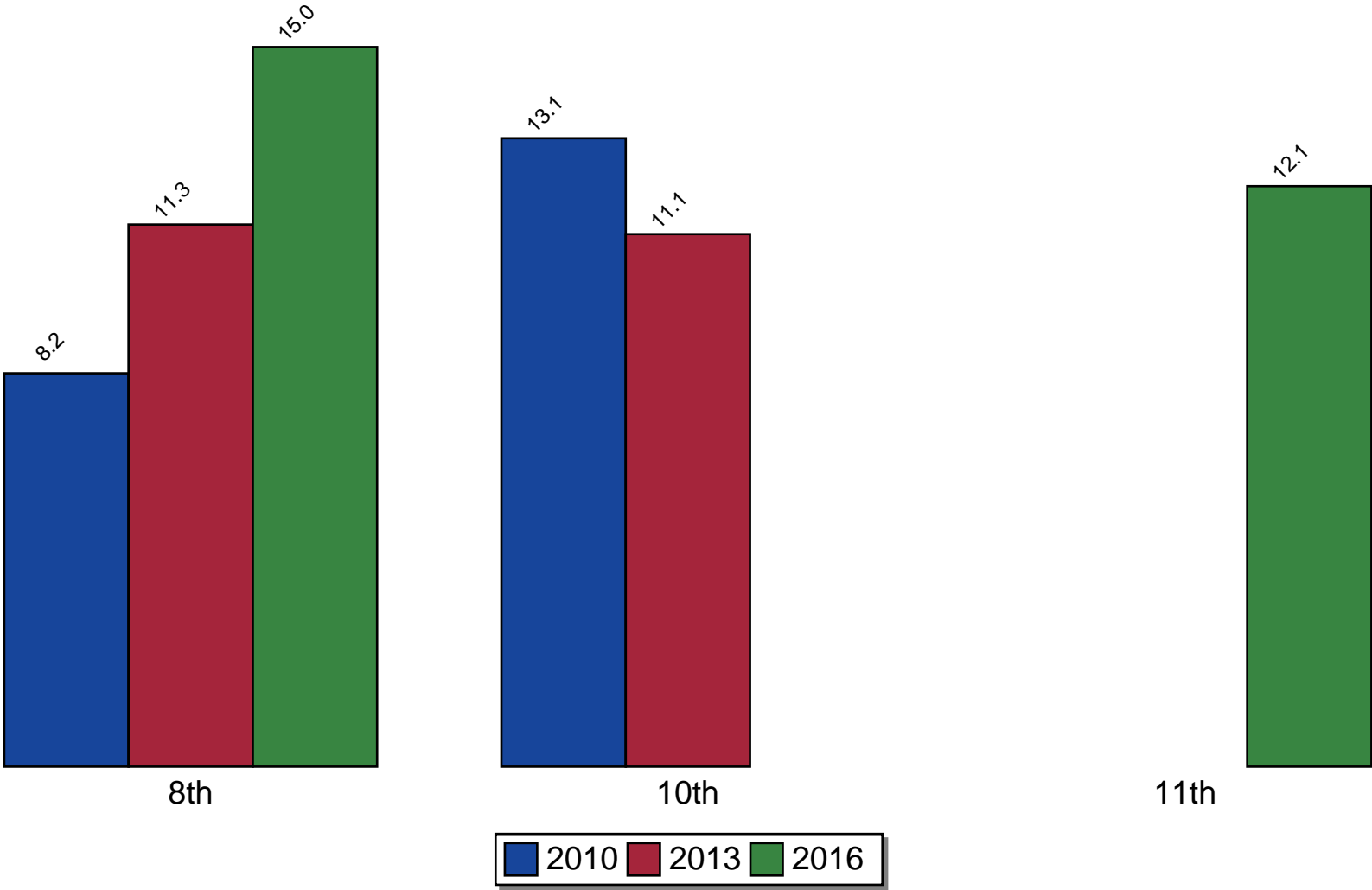

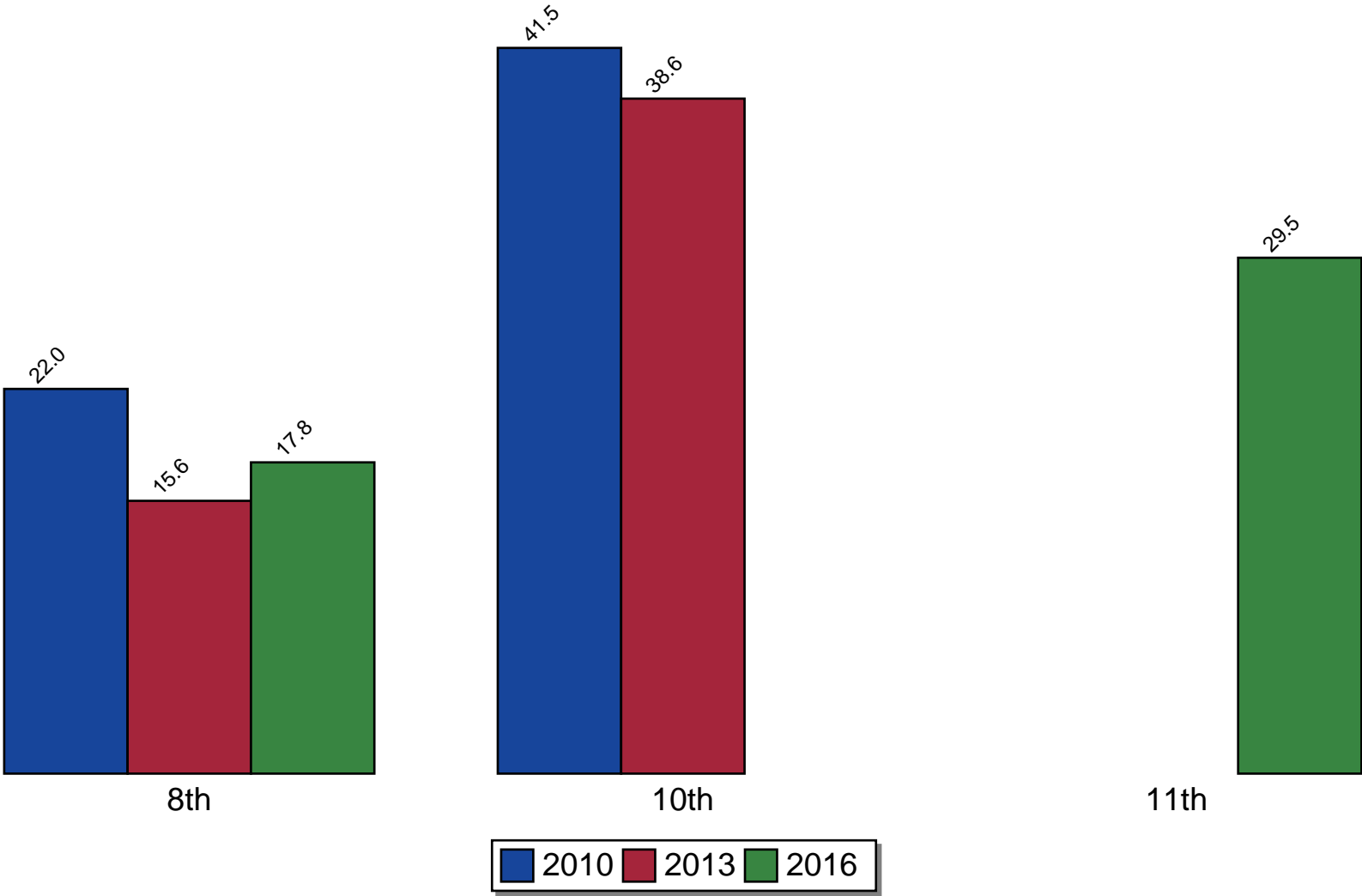

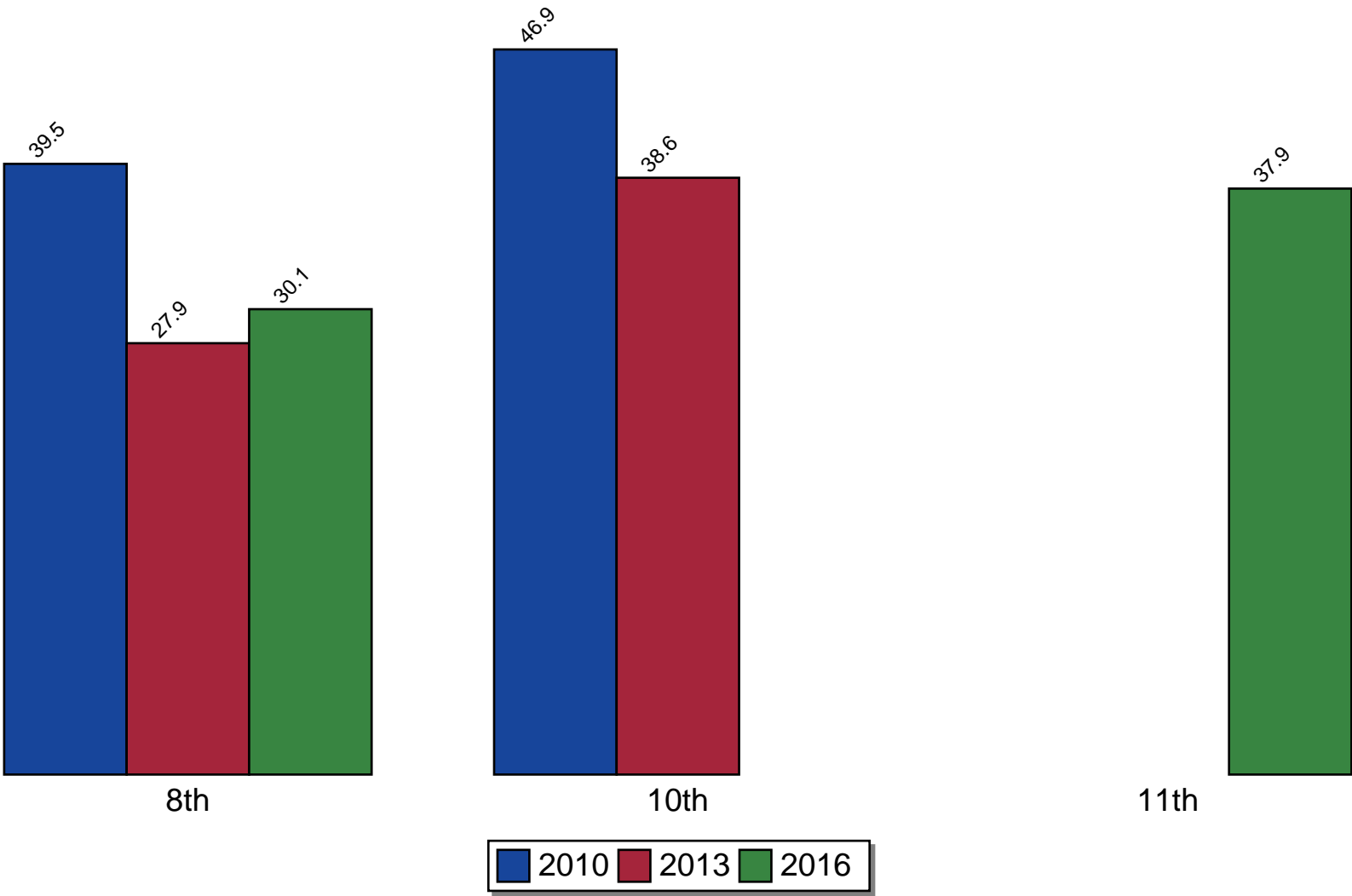

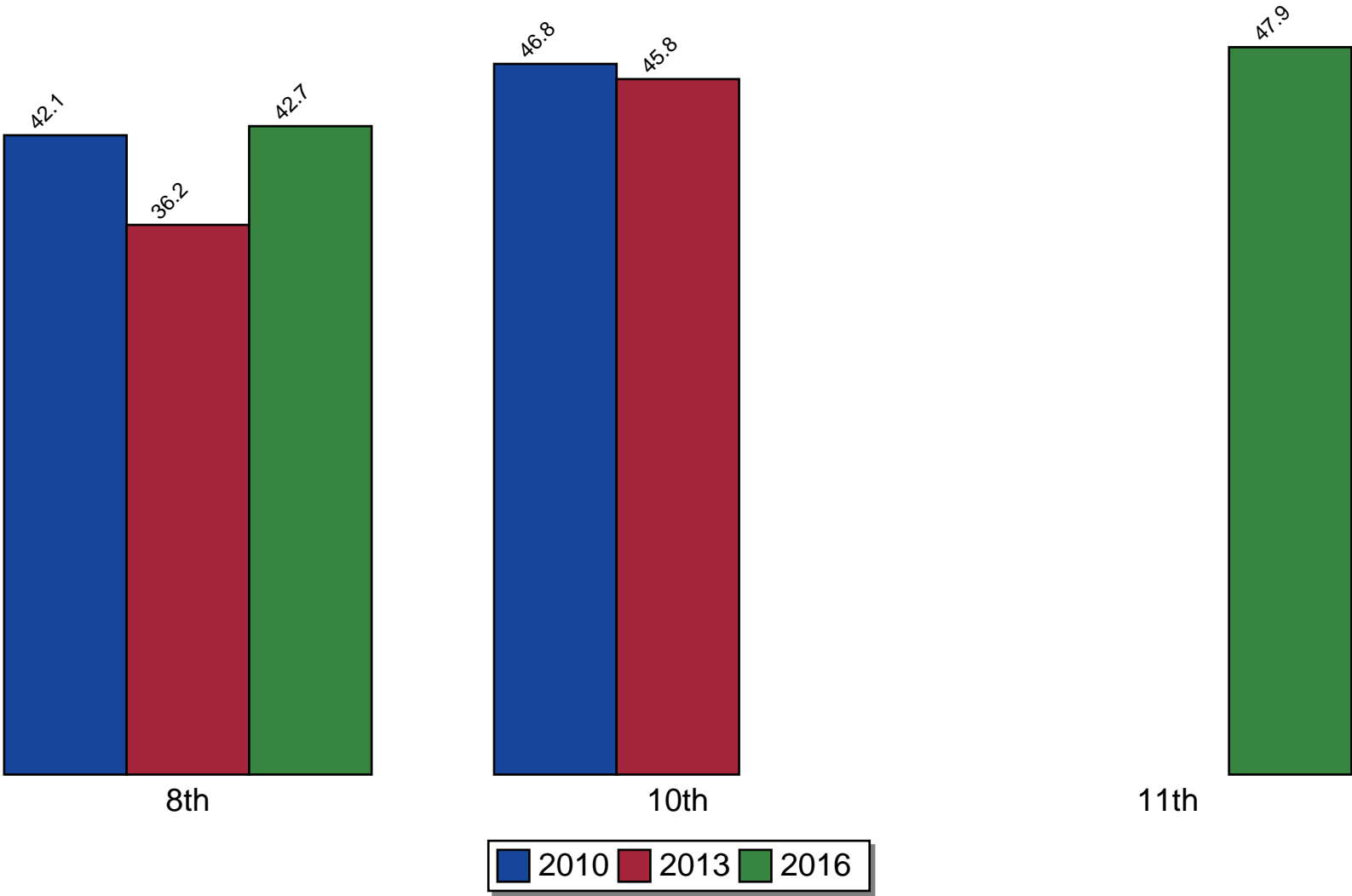

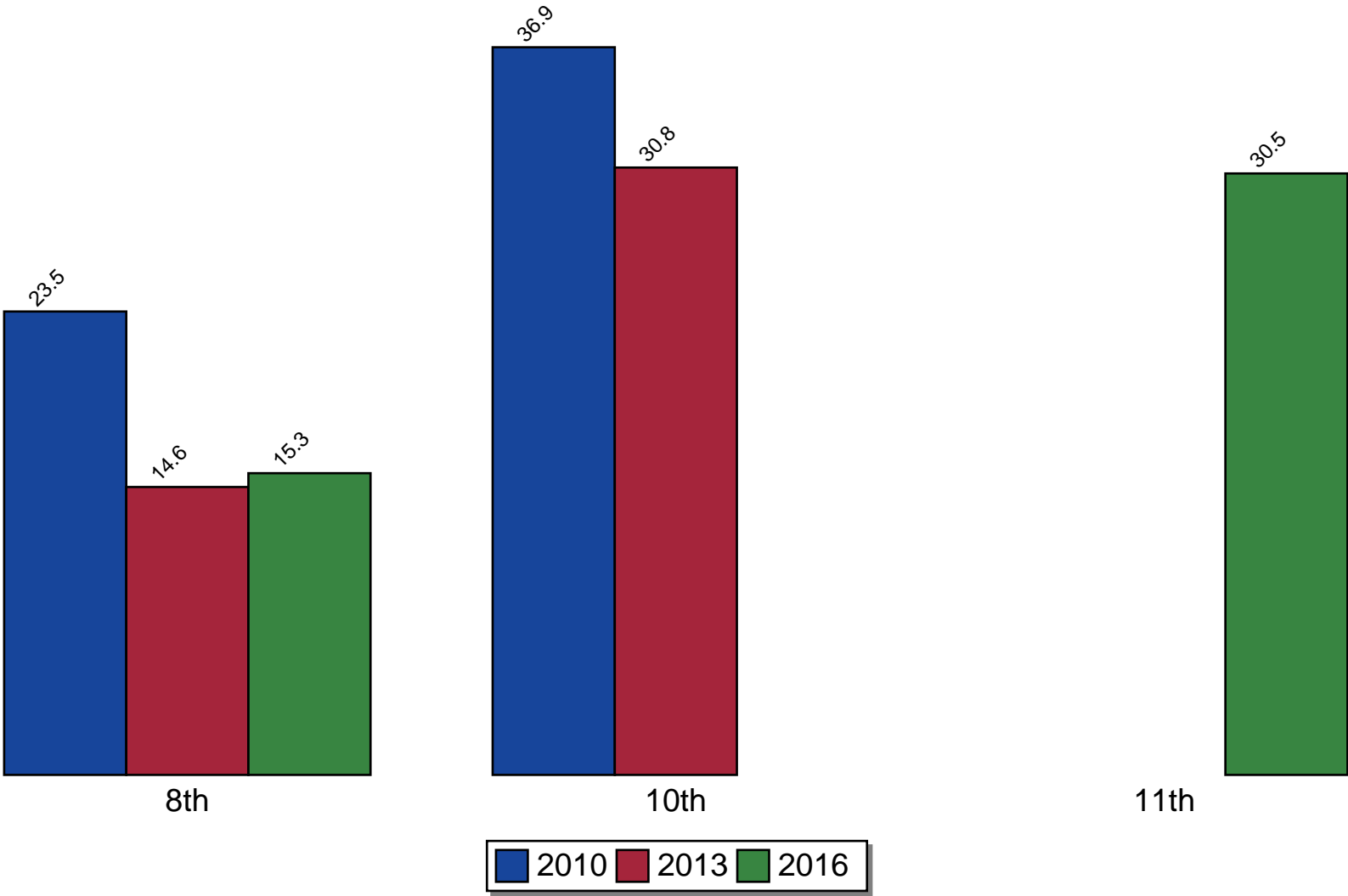

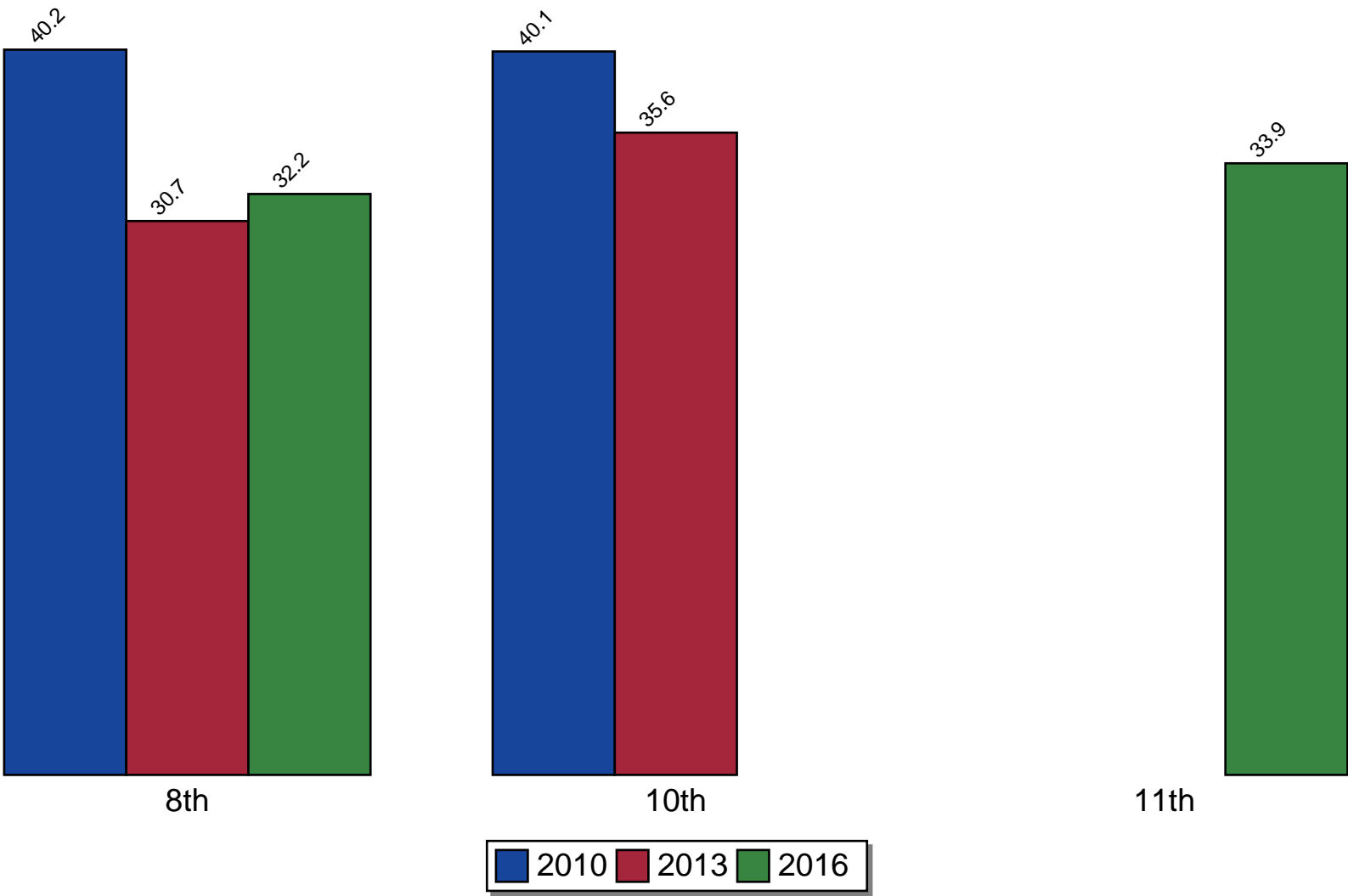

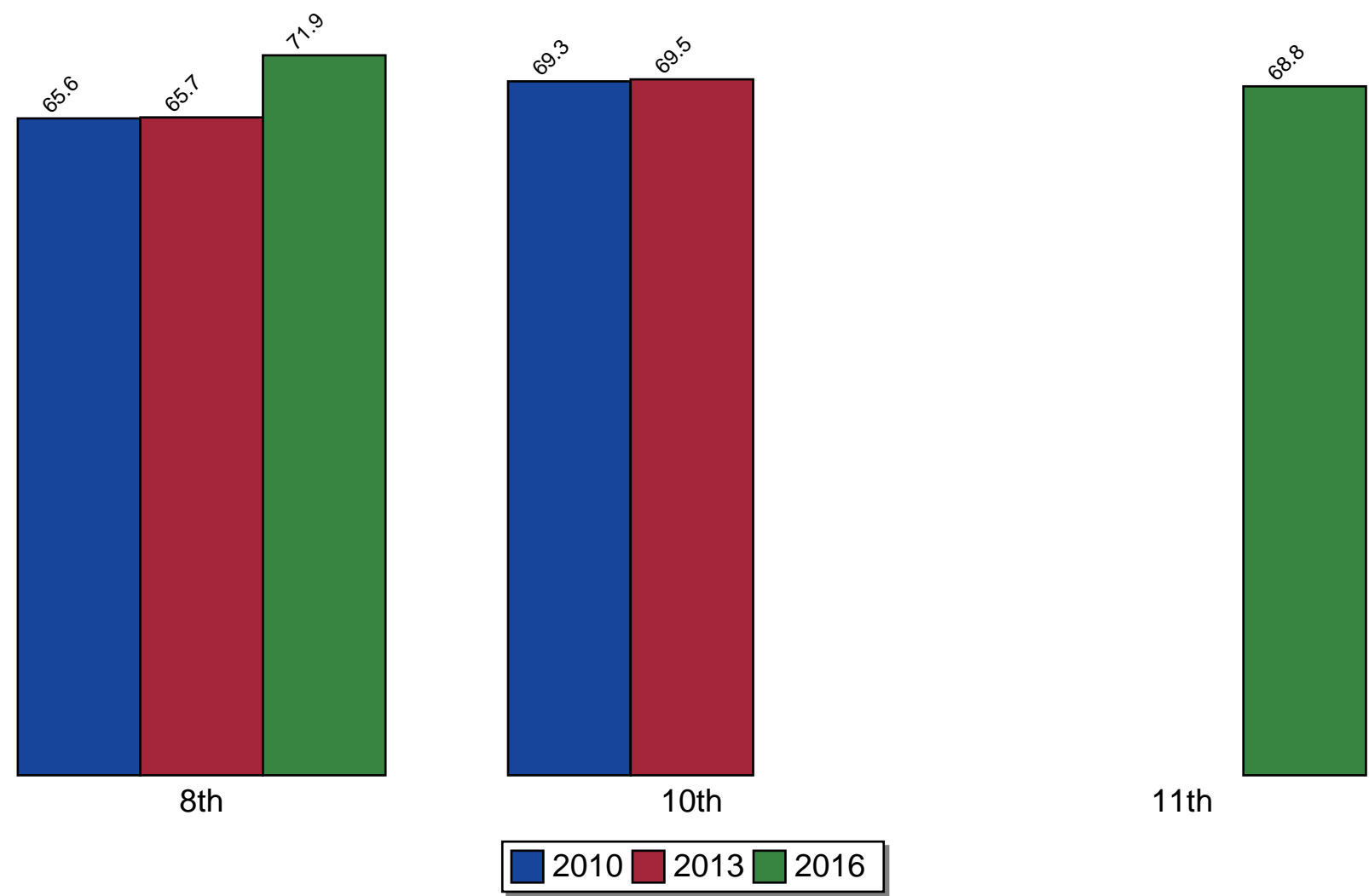

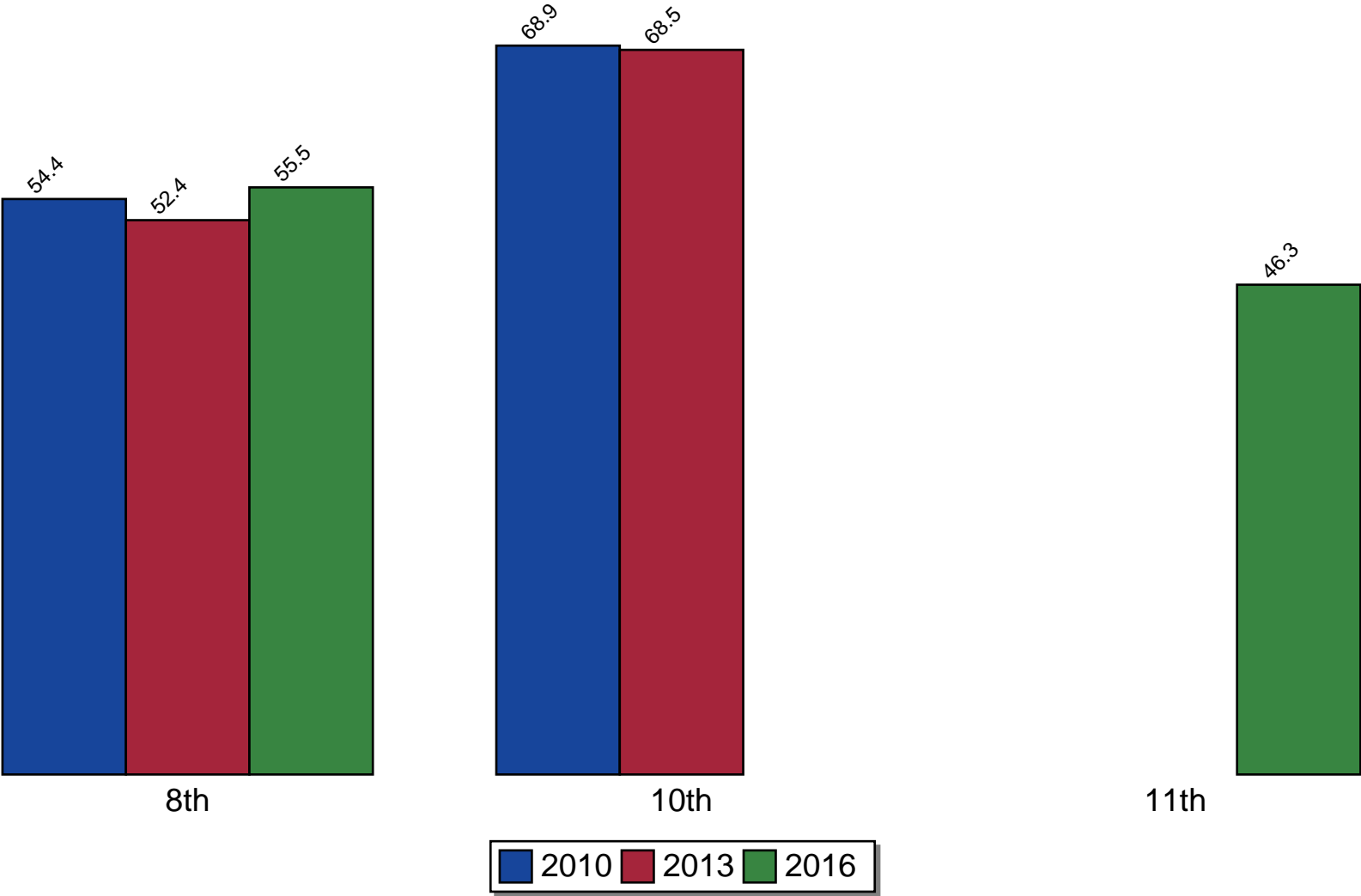

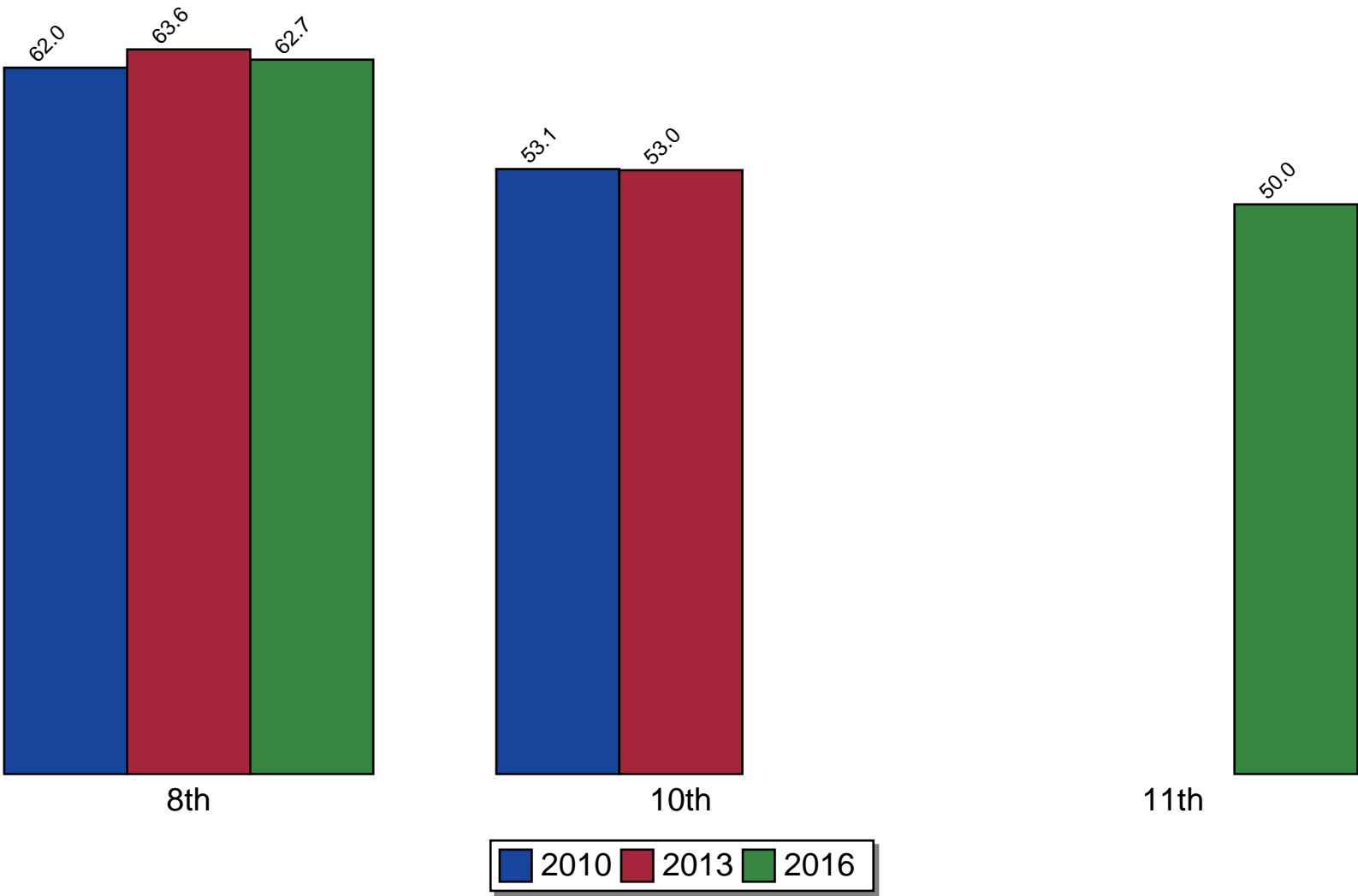

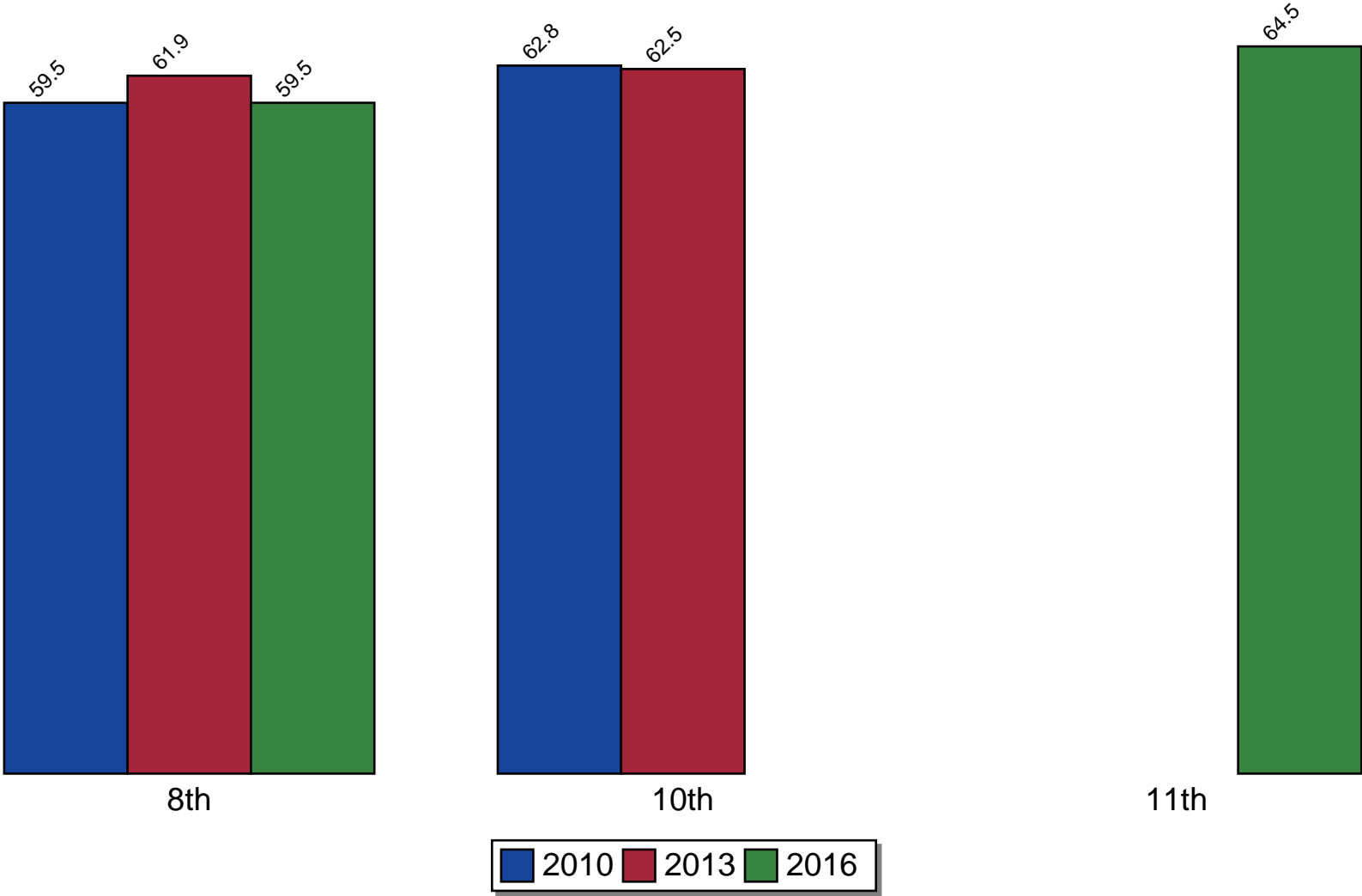

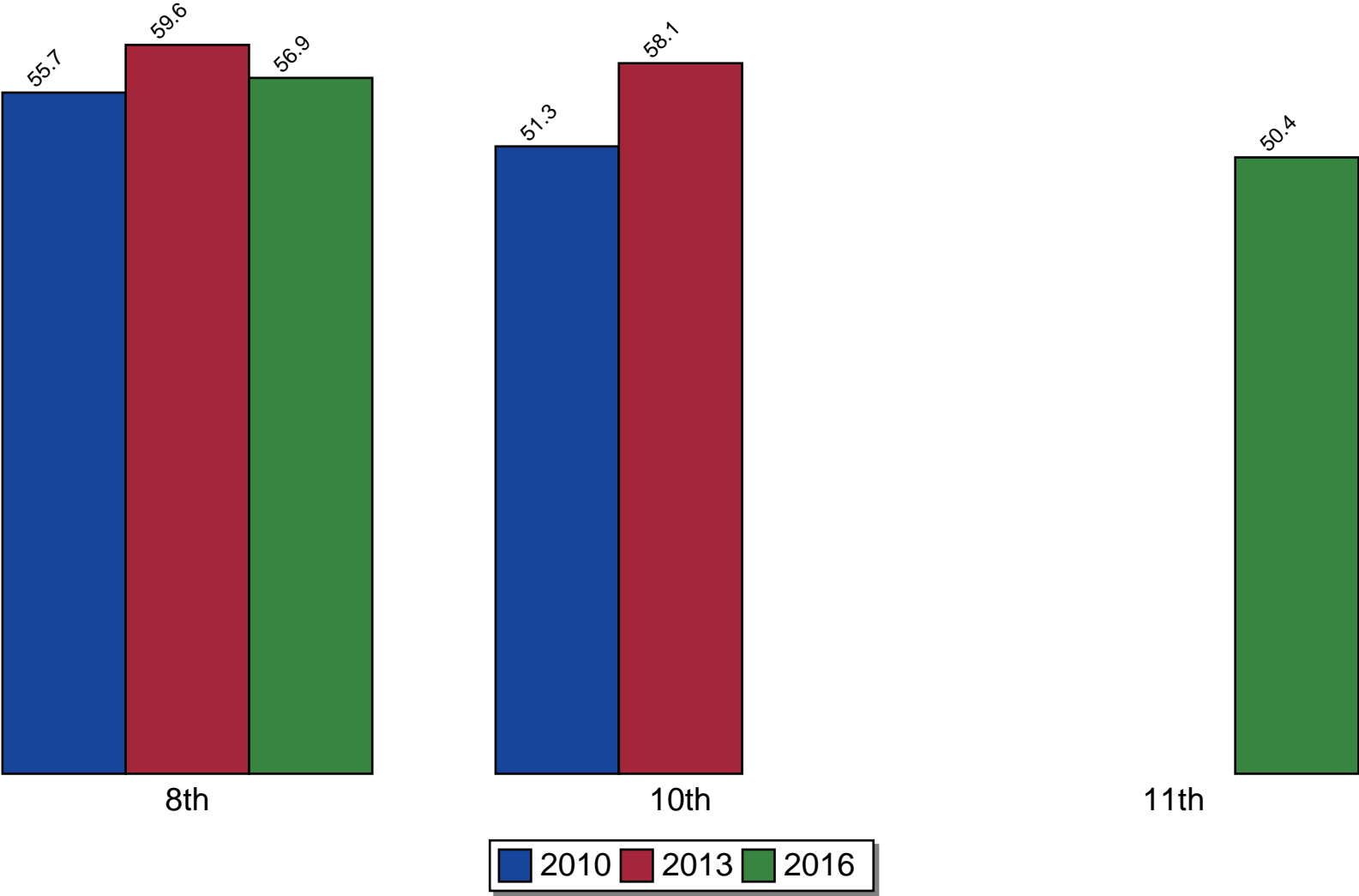
